The PRO Housing grant application outlines community development and affordable housing project proposals that will be supported with the federal funding source administered by MOHCD and CPC during the program year that starts on January 31, 2024 and ends on September 30, 2029.

The estimated amount of funding the City and County of San Francisco will receive from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is \$4 million. Please note that at the time of this notice, the funding amount has not yet been issued by HUD.
