Re: Community Health Care Planning Ordinance Notice for Sutter Bay Hospitals Mission Bernal Adult and Pediatric Clinics

Dear Secretary to the Health Commission:

In accordance with the Community Health Care Planning Ordinance (Proposition Q, 1988), Sutter Bay Hospitals is required to notice the Health Commission for any closures, changes in management, or reduction of inpatient or outpatient services. Sutter Bay Hospitals hereby formally gives notice that it intends to close the Mission Bernal Adult Clinic and the Mission Bernal Pediatric Clinic (including afterhours service), with the assets of both being donated to, in connection with an operating grant of support, Mission Neighborhood Health Center (MNHC), a federally qualified health center (FQHC), which will continue to operate similar clinics pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 1204(a).

I enclose copies of public notices announcing the closure of the two clinics by Sutter Bay Hospitals with opening by MNHC to immediately follow, timing subject to MNHC receiving approval from the California Department of Public Health to operate the clinics.

Sutter Bay Hospitals and MNHC have been working together to prepare for the change in provider. There will be a slight reduction in services for pediatric after hours care at the existing location. We do not anticipate a reduction of services for adult and regular-hours pediatric care, rather a move of the program from Sutter Bay Hospitals to a local FQHC which is well-positioned to manage the healthcare of the impacted population.

Our teams will work with patients and our community partners to ensure a seamless transition to implement these changes.
