CAUTIOUS OPTIMISM

After a very challenging year, including a winter surge in COVID-19 cases, we are starting to see the bright light at the end of the tunnel.

CAUTIOUS OPTIMISM

What makes us hopeful?

- Decline in cases: No resident COVID-19 cases since January 18, 2021
 and just one case among staff in March and April thus far.
- COVID-19 unit census: No residents in our COVID-19 unit since mid-February.
- Vaccines: High vaccination rates among residents (91%) and staff (84%).
- Community trends: Generally positive signs throughout the Bay Area and California.
- Ongoing commitment of our staff, residents, and families: The LHH
 community continues to carefully follow COVID-19 response protocols.



SAFE REOPENING

After a year of great sacrifices, our focus is now on a safe reopening to resume the services and programs that benefit our residents.

Reopening safely requires close coordination between all departments and is lead by our Hospital Incident Command System.

- Vaccinations rates at Laguna Honda and in our communities
- Local, state, and federal guidance
- LHH Infection Prevention and Control team guidance
- LHH Contact Investigation team guidance
- The voices of our staff, residents, and resident families

SAFE REOPENING - CLINICAL OPERATIONS

Reopening highlights from clinical operations:

- Nearly all clinics have reopened
- Expanding admission sources, including resuming home referrals
- Resuming in-person treatment groups
- Preparing to bring back trainees and students in the coming months

SAFE REOPENING – RESIDENT ACTIVITIES

Reopening highlights from resident activities:

- Expanding visits to include on-unit visits beginning on April 19, 2021
- Resuming Art with Elders and animal-assisted activities
- Resuming beside communions
- Resuming in-person Resident Council meetings
- Resuming resident grooming and other quality of life activities
- Planning for future reopening this spring/summer:
 - Chapel services
 - Medical Clowns on units
 - Opening the café

- More group activities
- Residents out on pass
- Bus-based city tours



NOT LETTING DOWN OUR GUARD

As we reopen, some things are not changing just yet.

- Universal masking: Staff continue to mask at all times on campus.
- Frequent testing: Staff and residents continue to be tested regularly through "screening testing."
- Daily screenings: Everyone entering the buildings goes through a health check.
- COVID-19 Response Protocols: Our COVID-19 Response Protocols, first developed in March, are still in place and we are ready to respond to any new cases or outbreaks.
