WILLIAM ALEXANDER LEIDESDORFF WAS ONE OF SAN FRANCISCO'S FOUNDERS. HE WAS BIRACIAL, ORIGINALLY FROM THE CARIBBEAN, BUT HE PASSED FOR WHITE. HE HAD A GREAT IMPACT ON THE GROWING COMMUNITY. HE BUILT THE FIRST HOTEL IN SAN FRANCISCO, AS WELL AS THE FIRST COMMERCIAL WAREHOUSE IN THE CITY. LEIDESDORFF STREET IS NAMED AFTER HIM.
