B - Southern	4		An officer spoke inappropriately with the complainant, placed the handcuffs too tight, and drove their patrol vehicle in a reckless manner. The officer behaved inappropriately.
C- Bayview	2	1	An officer failed to investigate properly and did not notify when the case was closed. The officer failed to properly investigate a report of an assault. In addition, an officer was rude and dismissive.

E- Northern	2	1	The Department of Police Accountability opened a mandated investigation into an officer-involved shooting. The complainant stated that an officer behaved inappropriately and a commanding officer failed to intervene.
