City/County of SF ROV Updates - No update from City/County of SF ROV. - Mr. Arntz inquired about the status of development of an RCV module in the VotingWorks system. VotingWorks indicated development of the RCV module has not taken place.	John Arntz
 VotingWorks Updates – No updates but questions below. SOS comments in RED. Original comments to regulations were provided 4 months earlier and Voting Works/SF Board of Supervisors is frustrated that no response has been provided to their comments/changes. SOS is working to review all comments regarding the regulations. However, all responses to the comments must follow OAL protocol. All members of the public that took part in the regulatory process will be made aware of any updates to the regulations during the regulatory process with OAL. VotingWorks was under the impression that the monthly call was to discuss the Pilot Program regulations and monitor regulation development. SOS advised Voting Works that the monthly San Francisco/Voting Works 2023 Pilot Plan Monthly Status Meeting was intended to keep all parties abreast of the development of the SF/Voting Works voting system to be presented for pilot in 2023 and that the meeting was not a private forum to discuss the statewide regulations or their development. VotingWorks has a system developed and ready for use in an election. They have been working with other states on development but have made no further development of the system with SF. SOS verified with Steve Trout that VotingWorks has a system developed and ready for use in an election. However, development of the RCV module as required by SF has not been developed. Additionally, Steve has confirmed that no further work on the SF has taken place since submittal of the initial application in January of 2022. 	Steve Trout
