Julia Marks is the Voting Rights Program Manager and Staff Attorney at Asian Americans Advancing Justice - Asian Law Caucus. She works for a more inclusive and representative democracy through advocacy around the census, redistricting, and elections, with a focus on AAPI & AMEMSA communities and immigrants. She and her team have provided technical assistance to organizations on census, redistricting, and voting rights, led a statewide redistricting collaborative, monitored elections across Northern California, advocated for improved services for voters who need language assistance, and co-sponsored California legislation regarding local redistricting. Before joining the Asian Law Caucus, she clerked for the Hon. Keith P. Ellison of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas. Julia previously litigated civil rights class actions and other high-impact cases at Disability Rights Advocates to expand access to public- and private-sector services for people with disabilities. She received her J.D. from the University of California, Berkeley School of Law.
