The contract services will be monitored in accordance with all applicable Departmental procedures through the Public Health Division.

Nondiscrimination and Cultural Competency:

The Department will work closely with the Contractor to ensure that their cultural competency plan is current and in compliance with Departmental procedures.

Other Significant Issues:

The Contractor shall provide ongoing support in COVID 19 testing services at potential community testing sites to reduce further exposures and infections. City Health provides low barrier, easily accessible testing with rapid results turnaround to decrease the disease burden in San Francisco.

City Health is a Medical Corporation registered in California. The company owns two urgent care centers in the Bay Area and a CLIA complex laboratory in Encino. City Health has been at the forefront of the COVID-19 pandemic, operating numerous testing locations throughout California, as well as offering testing services to a wide range of municipal and corporate partners, schools, and travelers to and from Hawaii and international destinations.
