The following Anticipated Forward Debt Calendar outlines the estimated amounts of each future General Obligation Bond issuance, the estimated timing for Board of Supervisors approval, and the estimated pricing/closing dates for bond issuances currently anticipated through fiscal year 2024-2025.

## Upcoming GO Bond Sales:

The Office of Public Finance expects to introduce resolutions to the Board of Supervisors approving the sale and issuance of Series 2024A (Earthquake & Emergency Response 2020), Series 2024B (Affordable Housing 2019), Series 2024C (Affordable Housing 2024), and Series 2024D (Embarcadero Seawall 2018) General Obligation Bonds ("the 2024 Bonds") in September 2024. Assuming introduction in September, OPF expects to close on the 2024 Bonds sometime in the first half of FY25. Additionally, an issuance for the 2016 PASS Affordable Housing bond is anticipated later in FY25.
