



- Cohesive campus design that maximizes the best attributes of the site, and creates a unified departmental vision




















PHASE 1 - ADAPTIVE RE-USE / GUT RENOVATION



CAMPUS PEDESTRIAN CONNECTION







- 4) planting mostly natives














SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC WORKSCITY & COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO





PERSPECTIVE OF TYPICAL OFFICE / LAB ENVELOPE



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








