- Movable facility providing police, government, and nonprofit services to areas based on need



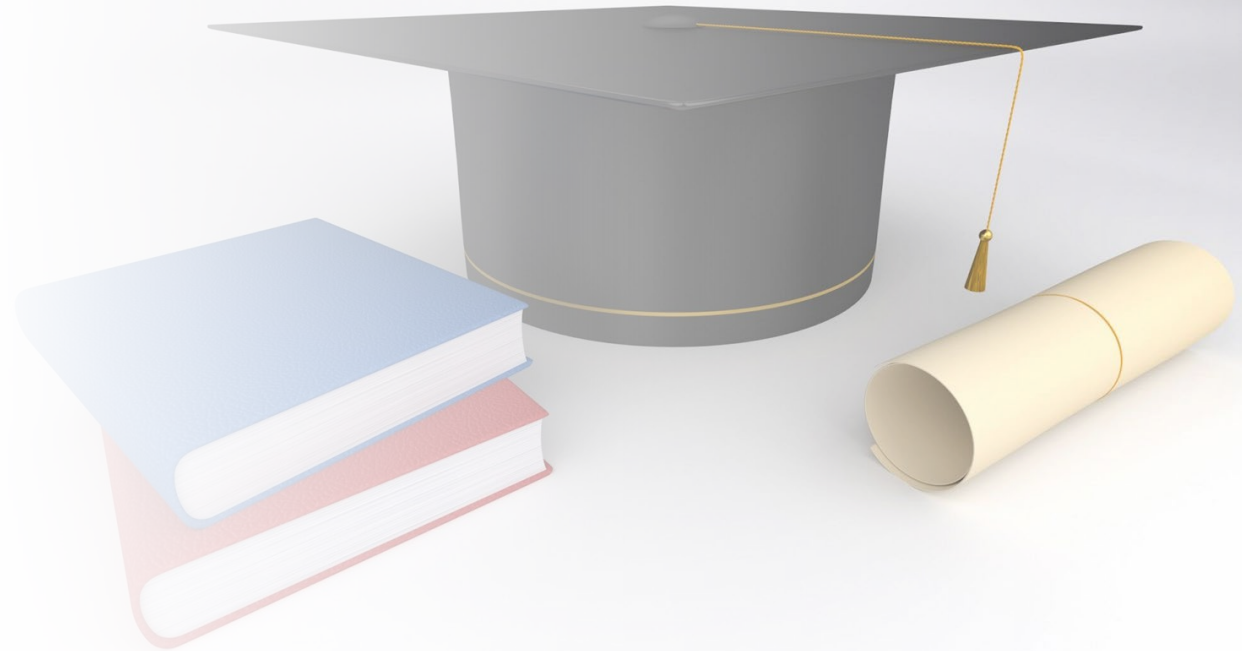
Peace Partner Collaboratives

What we know....

- ❖ Public safety is the responsibility of the police and every member of the public
- ❖ Disorder and criminality are correlated
- ❖ Active neighborhoods are safer
- ❖ The presence of police and natural guardians promote positive norms
- ❖ Assigning police to locations in distressed neighborhoods is a force multiplier

Peace Partners Collaborative Objective

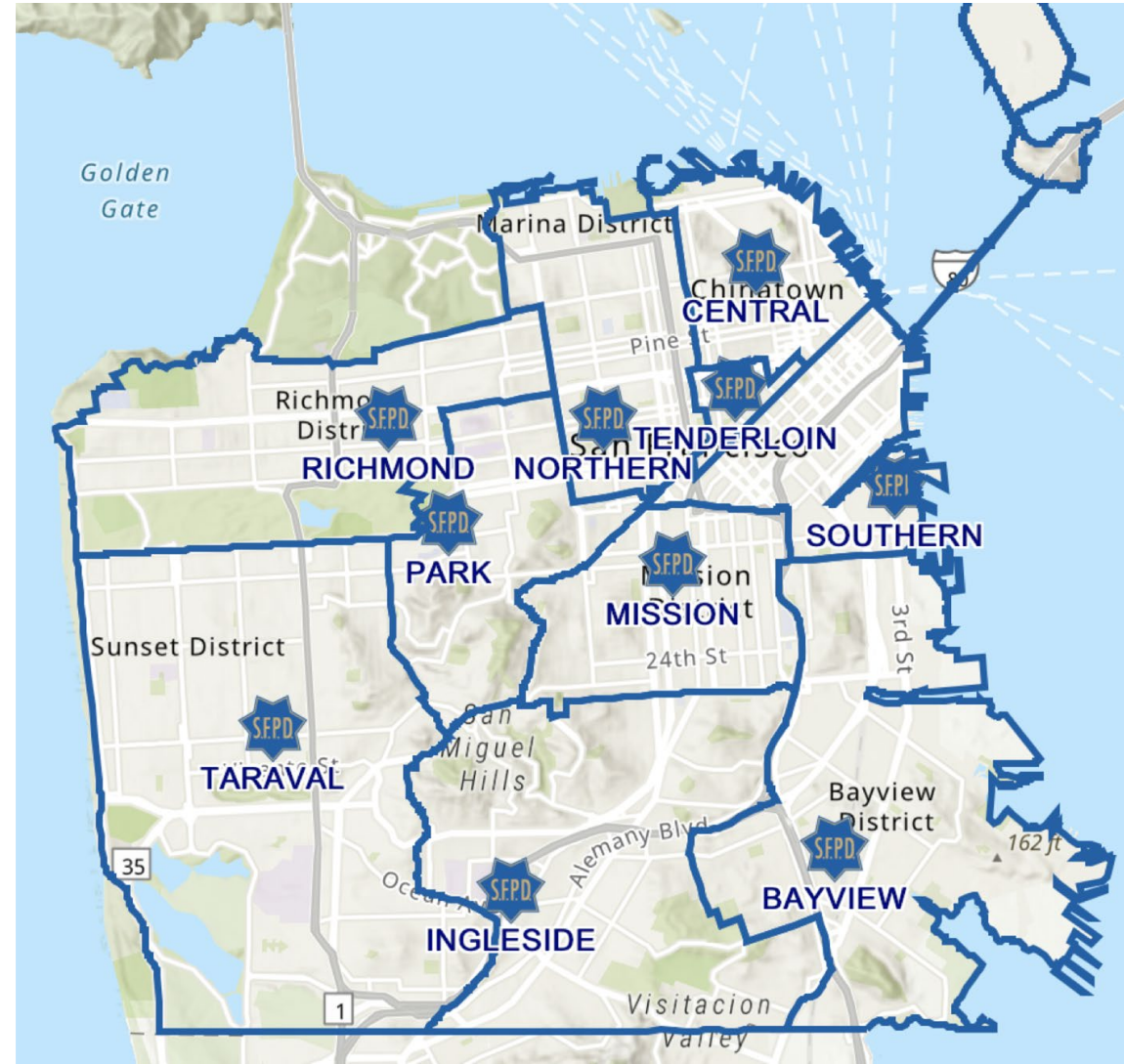
To craft their Peacelet to best reflect their neighborhood's needs and values by strategizing and deploying the collective efforts and resources of both SFPD and SF CBOs.

2 CBO providers

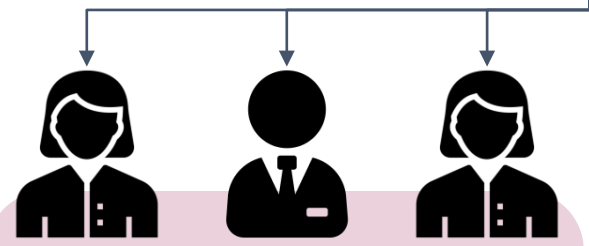
- Offer linkages or information on city or community services:
 - Housing
 - Behavioral health
 - Substance use recovery
 - Food access



2 police officers

- Offer attention to urgent police issues in the immediate area
 - Retail theft in the area
 - Car break ins

3 CBO providers

- Substance use specialist
- Housing Navigator
- Mental Health Assessor



2 police officers

- Provide support to CBO providers
- Establish guardian presence in surrounding area

Example: Chinatown & North Beach Peacelet



1 CBO provider

- Community health worker



3 police officers

- Walk the area to deter break ins
- Have immediate response for criminal activity
