


#### **GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 29% compared to 2023**

- There were 4 non-fatal shooting incidents causing injuries to 4 victims this week.
  - Note A victim suffered non-fatal injuries during a homicide incident on 07.08.24 bringing the total of non-fatal victims for the week to 5
  - o For the year, there are a total of 76 firearm-related incidents resulting in 86 victims
- There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 07.14.2024
  - o There are 18 homicides YTD with 13 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 94% for 2024







