## Highlights for July 17, 2024

The following report includes the Department of Police Accountability's recent developments:

- ◆ DPA is presenting four cases in closed session tonight, which represent 1/3 of all cases pending before the Commission.
- ◆ DPA attorneys attended a meeting at IAD to discuss how discipline cases move through our respective systems and try to improve efficiency.

## Investigation Updates

- ◆ **Cases Opened/Closed:** Our office opened 9 new cases and closed 28 cases since the last Commission meeting.
- ◆ **Cases Pending:** We've reduced cases pending by 8% since the last update.
