Resuming Admissions



Admissions began by welcoming back former residents

- After a more than two-year pause in new admissions, we re-welcomed a former Laguna Honda resident on Wednesday, July 31st!
- Laguna Honda has contacted all former residents who were transferred at the direction of CMS. We are in the process of readmitting ten former residents and may receive applications from other former residents, which we will prioritize.
- **Since resuming admissions, Laguna Honda has admitted three people, all from the first priority group (former Laguna Honda residents).**
- We thank all teams involved in admissions planning for making this possible, as well as our unit staff and resident care teams.

Eligible SFHN patients

Patients at non-SFHN medical facilities



Surge Lifted for COVID-19



Decrease in cases among residents and staff

- Surge protocol was initiated on July 1 and lifted on July 31 in response to a decrease in COVID cases and transmission.
- Certain precautions remain in effect given that skilled nursing settings are more vulnerable to respiratory illnesses.
- As of August 8, 2024, there are three units on outbreak status and 3 active resident cases and 10 active staff cases.
- As of August 8, 71% of residents are up-to-date on their vaccine.



Certification Update



Update on triple rooms at Laguna Honda

- Laguna Honda is committed to recertifying the 120 beds that we were required to remove based on federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) regulations.
- We continue to make clear to the California Department for Public Health (CDPH) and CMS the need to recertify the 120 beds and in turn, CDPH and CMS have made clear they are prepared to receive and consider a waiver application once Laguna Honda has demonstrated a sustained period of regulatory compliance.
- Laguna Honda will submit the waiver application at the earliest opportunity to ensure success.

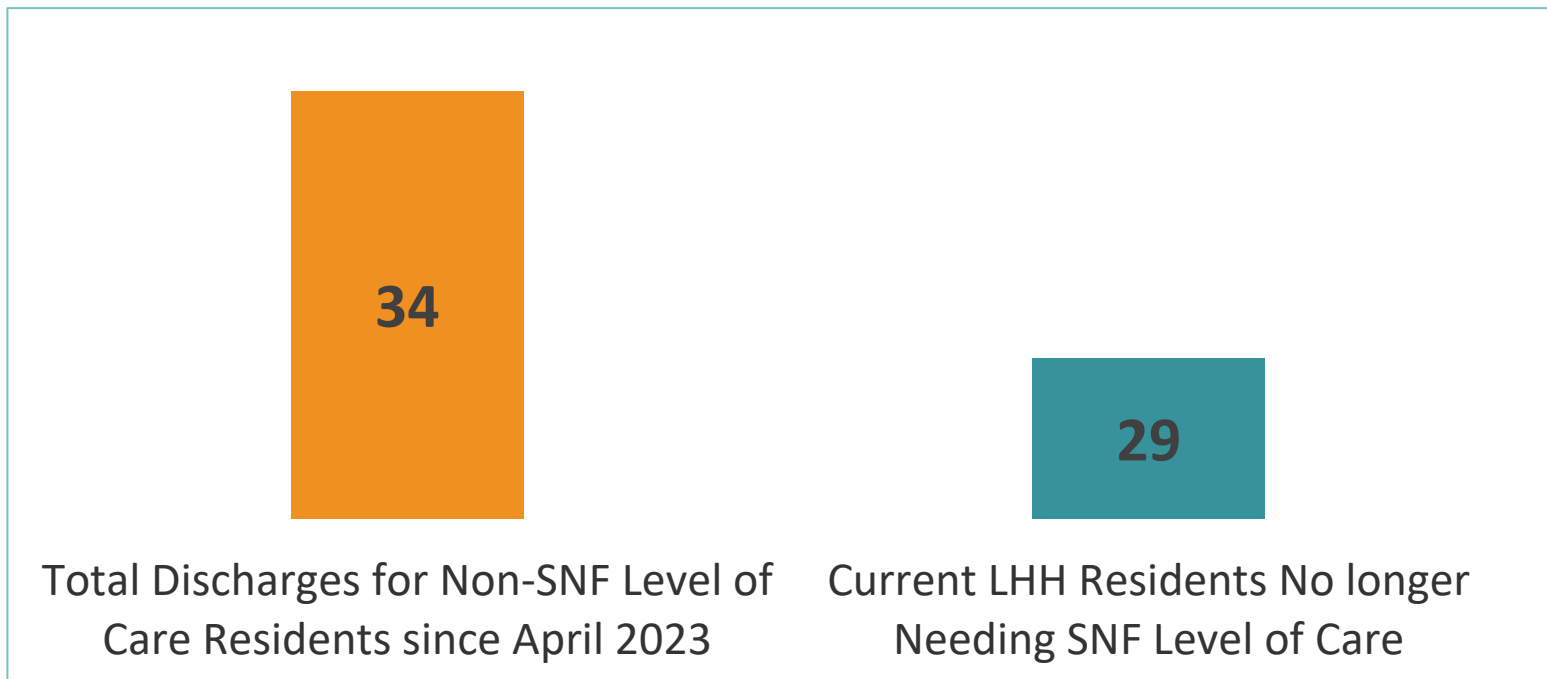


Discharge Update



Process to discharge residents with non-SNF level of care

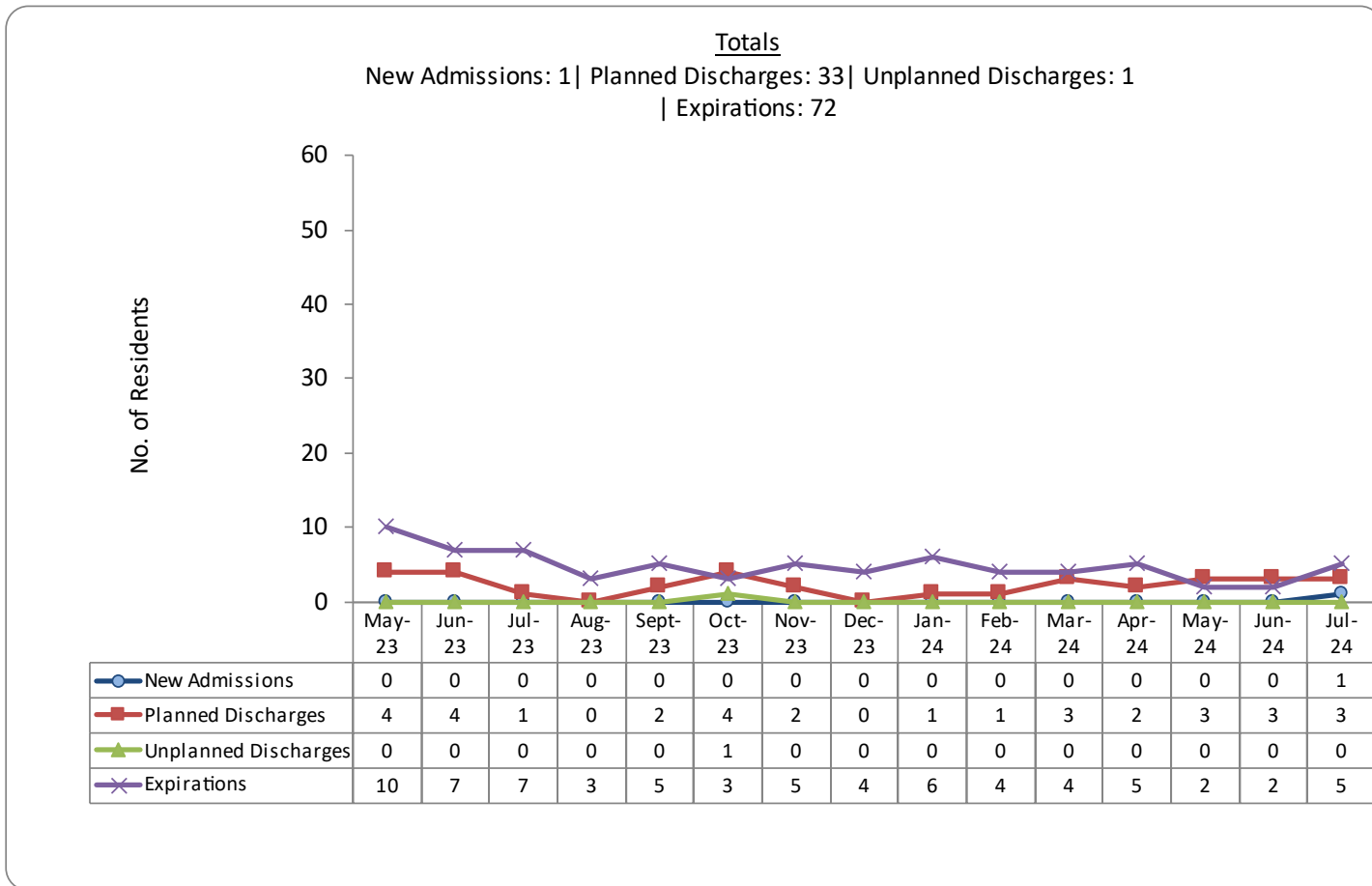
- Laguna Honda is actively working to discharge residents who no longer require skilled nursing facility-level (SNF) care.
