**Purpose of Contract:**

Pacific Neurophysiological Systems LLC shall provide intraoperative neurophysiological monitoring services at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (ZSFGH). All services shall be rendered by board certified neurophysiologists on a scheduled and "on-call" basis and will be requested by surgeons or their associates in the programs of ZSFGH.

For spine & cranial surgeries, the standard of care is to have a specially trained technologist present to monitor the patient's nervous system intraoperatively. The technologist applies a series of electrodes and surface adhesive pad electrodes to various parts of the patient's body. The electrodes transmit signals to a computer, which the technologist controls and uses to communicate information to the surgeon in real time. Potential changes in the nervous system are noted in real time vs. discovering damage done after the patient recovers from anesthesia. This reduces the risk of nerve damage up to paralysis.

Pacific Neurophysiological Systems LLC is a Local Business Enterprise (LBE) firm certified by the San Francisco Contract Monitoring Division. The firm provides various intraoperative monitoring services with surgical specialties.

Pacific Neurophysiological Systems LLC was selected under RFP Sourcing Event ID# 00000085787 conducted by the Department of Public Health. Pacific Neurophysiological Systems LLC was the second highest ranked proposer and is designated as the backup contractor to Golden Gate Neuromonitoring.

**Performance Monitoring:**

The contract will be monitored in accordance with hospital monitoring procedures by the Program Manager assigned to these services.
