Inactive Cases:

- Unknown Suspect/No DNA Uploaded to CODIS for later ID. No other probative evidence
- Unknown Suspect/ DNA Uploaded but not yet identified
- Victim becomes uncooperative or refused any further contact after SAEK Evidence collected at Rape Treatment Center
- Known Suspect/Victim cooperative. Suspect thought the sex was consensual and there is no other corroborating evidence

Cleared Cases:

- Cases that are adjudicated/ Arrest Made
- Outside Jurisdiction Investigations, SAEK completed at SFGH/Rape Treatment Center (crime occurred on SF State, UCSF, US Park Fed Land, CHP jurisdiction)
- Victim terminates investigation and signs "Affidavit of Termination"
- Statute of Limitations reached, case formally closed out
