


Dept. Wide Traffic Violations & Focus on the Five Violations 1/1/2024 – 6/30/2024

Department-Wide Total Traffic Violations Issuance





Department Wide Focus on the Five Traffic Violation Issuance by Quarter




Department-Wide Traffic Violations by Mode 1/1/2024 – 6/30/2024

- 1. A driver suffered medical issues prior to a crash at S. Van Ness and 18th Street.
- 2. Crash that occurred on 500 Buckingham Way was excluded as it happened in a parking lot.


