He has organized exhibitions and programming in San Francisco, New York and internationally, including Notes for Tomorrow (Independent Curators) International, 2021-Present), Letter from the Network (Berkeley Art Center, 2024) Under the Same Sun (Edge on the Square, 2023) Notes on Cultural Evidence (slash art, 2023), Conversations on Carlos Villa: World-Making and Cross-Cultural Solidarity (Asian Art Museum, 2022), Tarsal by Metatarsal (Headlands Center for the Arts, 2021), Solidarity Struggle Victory (Southern Exposure, 2019), and Rally: Queer Art and Activism (Dixon Place, 2017).
