


Overall Mission of SFPD Personnel

Protect	Prevent	Safeguard	Manage	Maintain

Deployment of Personnel - Definitions

- Step 1 Designation:
 - Officers and vehicles are designated for squad assignment.
 - During Step 1, personnel may still be used for routing district duties until activated (Step 4)
- Step 4 Dispatch:
 - Assembled Squads (Step 1) will be dispatched to other districts as needed, with instructions to report to a designated staging area.
- Passing Calls:
 - Monitor and assess
 - Visual presence



Incident Command System (ICS) – Form 214


- Used to document:
 - Incident/Event
 - Assigned resources
 - Notable Activities
- Used for Reimbursement and tracking purposes for each SFPD member

Deployment to Campuses within the City San Francisco State



APRIL 29, 2024

- Description:
 - Students created an encampment on SF State property (Lawn area)
- Staff Deployed:
 - Initially, step 4, two Officers from every station
 - Once notified by campus police event was peaceful, SFPD personnel withdrew to passing calls by on-duty Taraval officers
 - Passing calls continued during day and night from April 29 to approximately May 13 when encampment ended

Disposition of SFPD:

- Provide uniformed presence and monitored
- Initially, SFPD was support only
- Downgraded to monitoring only
- No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
- No Cost Recovery



Deployment to Campuses within the City University of California San Francisco



MAY 18, 2024

- Description:
 - Encampment of protestors, tents with plywood perimeter.
 - Use of amplified sound and bullhorns
- Staff Deployed:
 - Total 9: 2 sergeants, 7 officers, overtime only
 - Hours: 0400 0600 hours
- Disposition of SFPD:
 - Provided a uniformed presence
 - Support function only, step 1 (additional support as necessary if participants turned violent)
 - Maintained perimeter security outside campus property on Parnassus sidewalk
 - No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
 - No cost recovery



Deployment to Campuses within the City University of San Francisco



JUNE 10 and JUNE 11, 2024

- Description:
 - Encampment of protestors, tents in an open field on campus
- Staff Deployed:
 - None
 - Passing calls by on-duty officers
 - Hours: Day/Night
- Disposition of SFPD:
 - Monitor only.
 - USF personnel did not want uniformed officers on campus
 - No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
 - No cost recovery



Deployment to Campuses within the City University of California San Francisco



JUNE 27, 2024

- Description:
 - Press conference regarding students who participated in protest
- Staff Deployed:
 - None
 - Passing calls by on-duty officers
 - Hours: During press conference event
- Disposition of SFPD:
 - Monitor only.
 - USF personnel did not request uniformed officers on campus
 - No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
 - No cost recovery



Deployment to Campuses within the City University of California Regents



JULY 17 and 18, 2024

• Description:


 Protests at the UC Regents meeting held at the Mission Bay campus regarding encampment response, campus policing, and perceived suppression of free speech and student repression

• Staff Deployed:

- 3 sergeants, 21 officers, on-duty
- Hours: 0500 1600 both days

Disposition of SFPD:

- Traffic control
- Off-campus perimeter
- No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
- Cost recovery and ICS 214 filed



Outside Requests for Mutual Aid

- CALOES (California Governor's Office of Emergency Services)
 - Mutual Aid requested via CAL OES
 - Coordinated via SFPD DOC
 - DOC receives approval from Chief of Police and/or Assistant Chief of Operations
 - Briefings conducted prior to deployment
 - SFPD personnel follow all Department policies and procedures including uniform and equipment





Deployment to Campuses Outside the City Cal Poly Humboldt



April 29, 2024

Description:

- Demonstrators occupied building
- Campus police instructed occupants to vacate and was met with violent resistance
- Campus police did not have adequate resources.

Staff Deployed:

- 1 sergeant, 10 officers, overtime only
- Hours: 1100 hours midnight on 05/01/2024

• Disposition of SFPD:

- Provided a uniformed presence
- Some vehicular/pedestrian traffic control
- Assisted in a skirmish line ~block away from where host agency was enforcing laws/making arrests
- Support only for local police as needed/necessary due to possible violent participants
- No SFPD incidents, use of force, or reports
- Cost recovery and ICS 214 filed



Deployment to Campuses Outside the City University of California Santa Cruz



May 16, 2024

Description:

- Request made by host agency for standby stating not needed on campus
- Host agency notified that there were significantly more protesters than anticipated requesting mutual aid ASAP

• Staff Deployed:

- 1 sergeant, 10 officers, on-duty into overtime
- Hours: 0200 hours 1200 hours

Disposition of SFPD:

- Provided a uniformed presence
- Support only for local police if additional support was necessary due to violent protestors
- One SFPD officer was spat on, UCSC campus police took subject into custody
- No use of force or reports
- Cost recovery and ICS 214 filed



Deployment to Campuses Outside the City University of California Berkeley



May 31, 2024

- Description:
 - Demonstrators occupied building, fortified entrances, and vandalized property.
 - UCPD did not have adequate police resources to safely address the issue
- Staff Deployed:
 - 1 sergeant, 17 officers, on-duty with two of the officers were on overtime
 - Hours: 1445 hours 2330 hours
- Disposition of SFPD:
 - Provided a uniformed presence
 - Support only for local police if additional support was necessary due to violent protestors
 - No SFPD incidents, use of force or reports
 - Cost recovery and ICS 214 filed
