


GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 24% compared to 2023

- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim this week.
 - o For the year, there are a total of 102 firearm-related incidents resulting in 115 victims
- There were no homicide incidents for the week ending 09.15.2024
 - o There are 24 homicides YTD with 18 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 88% for 2024







