Pressure From All Sides

- Need and demand for our service continues to increase.
- \$10M City-Wide Grocery Contract to Fund "Pop-Up Pantries" for pandemic response was cut to \$6M in FY24, and was eliminated in FY25









How Many People Projected to Be Impacted



In Process of Phasing out Pop-Up Pantries by June 30, 2025



In FY 22 - 23 we reduced participants served through Pantry at Home (grocery deliveries) by 48%

Rebuild, Reimagine, Recommit



Rebuild

- Increase our Pantry Network capacity to rebuild from pandemic
- Increase choice for all participants at pantries

Reimagine & Reinvest

- Pilot new approaches to build capacity in Pantry Network
- Co-leadership with partners to build new approaches like Community Markets
