




Geary-Park Presidio Pedestrian Improvements








Street Repaving and Reconstruction

Recent accomplishments:

- 52 projects are completed
- 1,436 blocks have been resurfaced or 101% of the goal.



As of Dec'19, the City paved **1,436** blocks, or 112% of 1,275 blocks originally planned for the bond




Street Resurfacing Program funding included 2011 GO Bond and other sources.

• **65 projects** or 100% of the goal have been completed.






Curb Ramp Program


Accomplishments:


 1,563 curb ramps, or 115% of the goal, were designed, constructed, or upgraded to comply with ADA standards.

- Accelerated Sidewalk
 Abatement Program
 (ASAP) repaired 155,544
 or 102% of the goal

 properties.








Roadway Structure Program

Traffic Signals (SFMTA)

Accomplishments:

I. Transit Signal Priorities (TSP) - completed


- TSP engineering strategy to provide, whenever possible, green signal indications for transit vehicles as they approach signalized intersections, to minimize transit delays and enhance transit on-time performance.
- Completed TSP implementation at all Muni Rapid traffic signals.


II. New Traffic Signals in 10 intersections - completed


• New traffic signals at various locations to improve safety for pedestrians, rail transit, and vehicle traffic, as well as to enhance on-time performance.

III. Traffic Signal infrastructure upgrades - completed

 The SFMTA secured funds to improve safety along transit routes by upgrading traffic signal infrastructure at various intersections.
