



## Multicultural Student Stipend Program (MSSP)


#### Established in 1988

#### Fiscal Year (FY) 23/24 Multicultural Student Stipend Program







## Challenges

- Transition to Epic and developing credentialing process for interns has been a challenge that many of BHS leadership are working to resolve
- Vacancies amongst supervisors and Behavioral Health Clinician have impeded some sites
  that have historically hosted interns from hosting due to lack of supervisors that meet
  university and/or Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) guidelines this year
- Transition to EPIC and the stress involved also contributed to some sites that have historically hosted interns to opt out of hosting interns this year



## Opportunities

- The new 9910 Public Service Trainee positions to bridge interns after they graduate to Civil Service Positions overseen by David Nish
- JEDI pairing culturally congruent interns with Community Based Organizations (CBOs)
- National Health Service Corps (NHCS) expansion of stipends for interns/trainees
- Department of Healthcare Access and Information (HCAI) expansion of stipends for interns/trainees
- BHS Internship Program is expanding to Bachelor-Level Interns for Health Worker/Health Program Coordinators
- BHS Internship Program is expanding Bay Area Practicum Information Collaborative (BAPIC) memberships for psychologist interns
