Highlights for October 2, 2024

The following report includes the Department of Police Accountability's recent developments:

- ◆ The **Audit Division** received the Controller's independent review notes to the draft stop data audit. We are addressing the notes and hope to have an exit conference with SFPD later this month.

Investigation Updates

- ◆ **Cases Opened/Closed:** Our office opened 28 new cases and closed 17 cases since the last Commission meeting.
- ◆ **Allegation Trends:** The top allegation this week remained officers behaving or speaking inappropriately (Conduct Unbecoming).

Allegation Type	Allegation Summary	Percent
Conduct Unbecoming	The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.	24%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to take required action.	24%
Use of Force	The officer intentionally and improperly discharged a firearm, on or off duty, in the performance of law enforcement duties.	7%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to provide his or her name or star number.	5%
Neglect of Duty	The officer drove improperly.	5%
