Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST)

Transformation Update

- JPD, DPH, and Seneca launched the San Francisco juvenile justice Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST) program in August 2024.
- Target Population: Youth in the juvenile justice system living with their legal guardians who face multiple arrests or an arrest record of concerning or increasingly serious charges; behavior patterns beyond parental control or causing difficulties in school; and/or juvenile domestic violence. Youth may be referred pre- or post-adjudication, regardless of insurance status.
- Current point in time capacity: 5 youth 2 enrolled to date, 3 pending.
- Once all 3 clinicians are hired, capacity will be 15 youth.
