# Firearm Discharge Review Board

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024, the Firearm Discharge Review Board reviewed the following completed Officer-Involved Discharge:

- OIS 21-001

# Officer-Involved Shooting 21-001

On May 7, 2021, at approximately 1230 hours, SFPD Dispatch broadcasted information about suspects in a silver Mitsubishi committing auto burglaries in the area of Fisherman's Wharf.

Central Station Plainclothes Officers went out in three separate unmarked vehicles to different locations to try and locate the silver Mitsubishi and the suspects. The plainclothes sergeant started late that day. As the officers were leaving the station, they saw the sergeant and notified them as to their plan to attempt to locate the vehicle.

Two officers who were riding together located the silver Mitsubishi by the Ferry Building on the Embarcadero. They observed two of the occupants commit two separate auto burglaries, stealing luggage from parked vehicles.

# Officer-Involved Shooting 21-001 (cont'd)

The two officers relayed what they had witnessed to the other members of the team, as well as to their sergeant who was monitoring the officers on an encrypted channel while they got ready for their shift.

The officers followed the Mitsubishi into the Southern District where they temporarily lost sight of the vehicle. The officers located the vehicle parked at Varney Place & Jack London Alley. Two of the occupants were standing outside of the vehicle, rummaging through the stolen luggage. Another suspect was sitting in the driver's seat.

Officer #1 exited the vehicle and monitored the subjects on foot. Officer #2 parked the vehicle and joined Officer #1 on foot.

# Officer-Involved Shooting 21-001 (cont'd)

A plan was discussed by Officer #3 to use spike strips; however, they were unable to deploy the spike strips as an adjacent alley in front of the vehicle was blocked off due to construction.

The plainclothes team stated they did not call for a marked unit as often times the burglary crews carry scanners, and when they see or hear police presence, they will flee, putting the public at risk.

Officer #1 and Officer #2 formulated a plan to prone the suspects out at gun point and take them into custody.

Officer #1 and Officer #2 had their SFPD Stars displayed, and each had their gun out.

# Officer-Involved Shooting 21-001 (cont'd)

One of the subjects saw Officer #1 and jumped back into the Mitsubishi. The other suspect standing outside of the vehicle had not yet been alerted to the officers' presence.

Now that the officers had been spotted and to avoid the suspect from escaping, Officers #1 and #2 ran to the suspect. Officer #1 identified themselves by yelling, "Police Department!" and bear hugged the suspect.

Officer #1 heard a loud "Pop" and saw the suspect bleeding from the left arm. Officer #1 realized that they had their gun out and had unintentionally shot the suspect. Officer #1 explained that in their mind they truly believed that they had holstered their gun before running to grab the suspect.

Officer #1 rendered aid to the suspect and a tourniquet was applied. The sergeant responded to the scene after the OIS.
