
Adult Primary CE Assessment or Family Housing Prioritization Assessments




Coordinated Entry



- Identify as people of color: 87%








Housing Inventory Dashboard





Housing Placements







- Snapshot as of December 27, 2024
- Public dashboard available on HSH website; refreshes daily Monday Friday.
- Ability to filter for specific programs and populations served.





Family & Adult Shelter Waiting Lists

Family Shelter Waiting List

There are currently 278 families on the waiting list.

95 families joined the waiting list in November 2024.

In November 2024, 21 families were placed into non-congregate shelter from the list.

Adult Shelter Waiting List

There are currently 248 people on the waiting list.

587 people joined the waiting list in November 2024.

Average time on waiting list = 11 days (for people who accepted placement offers)

In November 2024, 92 people were placed into shelter from the reservation system.



Adult Shelter Waiting List Metrics: People Joining the Waiting List










Adult Shelter Waiting List Metrics: People Active on the List Over Time
