/A) (TD1 1		

- (A) The above stamp needs to be affixed on permit application forms including the following projects:
 - 1. Vertical addition
 - 2. Horizontal addition
 - 3. Rear decks
 - 4. In-Fill court
 - 5. Dormers
 - 6. Bay windows
 - 7. Balconies
- (B) The above stamp does not need to be affixed on permit application forms for the following project:
 - 1. Roof decks

Affixing subject stamp is not required for change in occupancy and change of number of dwelling units, provided that the building envelope is not enlarged. Excavation to create a basement also does not require affixing subject stamp.

Other conditions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by the Supervisor or Manager.
