If so, do I need to apply as a supplier with both entities separately?	The equity applicant may use their grant funds to support their other local commercial cannabis applications.
Do I need to have my Planning Department application submitted in order to qualify for the Direct Cannabis Grant application?	No, you do not need to have your Planning application submitted in order to qualify for direct grants.

What are the eligible expenses?	You can get reimbursed for expenses related to:
Do all expenses need to be accrued before the Grant application is submitted? Can the expenses be claimed before the Grant reimbursement in March? What is the cutoff date the OOC will be looking at for those expenses?	 Capital improvements Fixtures and equipment Legal services Local and State application, licensing, and regulatory fees Regulatory compliance Rent payments Laboratory testing of cannabis
	Invoices are subject to review and the OOC may follow up with inspections. Generally, all eligible businesses can get reimbursed for expenses incurred between August 2020 and March 2021.
Do I need to know exact expenses when I complete my application?	No, you do not need to provide exact figures. Please estimate your expenses. Your estimates will not lock you in – you can adjust your eligible expenses at a later time.
Do I need to complete my application in one sitting or can I return to it later?	The application must be completed at once. Eligible applicants will not be able to return to their grants application at a later time.
