

Recall Measure Regarding Alison Collins*

The Way It Is Now: Alison Collins is a member of the Board of Education for the San Francisco Unified School District (School Board).

At the City's November 6, 2018 election, she was elected for a four-year term ending on January 8, 2023.

The Proposal: Proposition ___ is a recall that would remove Alison Collins from the School Board ten days after the Board of Supervisors declares the results of this election. The Mayor would then appoint a replacement to serve on the School Board.

On November 8, 2022, the City will hold an election for School Board members, and the candidates elected at that time would serve for a full four-year term beginning on January 8, 2023. The replacement appointed by the Mayor may run as a candidate for the School Board at the November 8, 2022 election.

A "YES" Vote Means: If you vote "yes," you want to remove Alison Collins from the Board of Education for the San Francisco Unified School District.

A "NO" Vote Means: If you vote "no," you want to keep Alison Collins on the Board of Education for the San Francisco Unified School District.
