



# Getting your COVID-19 vaccine in San Francisco

**Getting vaccinated  
will help keep you,  
your family, and your  
community safe and  
healthy.**

**Everyone in San Francisco  
age 16 and over is now  
eligible to get the COVID-19  
vaccine.**

- **Vaccines are free to people  
who live, work or learn in  
San Francisco.**
- **You do not need insurance to  
book an appointment.**
- **Documentation (like an ID or  
SSN) is not required.**
- **Receiving the COVID-19  
vaccine does not count as  
a public charge and will not  
prevent you from becoming a  
permanent resident.**

## Information for 16-year-olds and 17-year-olds

- Not all vaccines are approved for  
16-year-olds and 17-year-olds.
- Check to see if a site is serving  
people 16 and older when you make  
an appointment.

## Find a list of vaccine sites at [sf.gov/GetVaccinated](https://sf.gov/GetVaccinated)

- If you have limited internet access, need assistance, or cannot travel to a vaccination site because of a disability, call the City hotline at **(628) 652-2700** for help with booking options. This hotline is prioritized for people ages 65 and older and people with disabilities.
- In addition to larger vaccine sites, there are many neighborhood locations which may change or be added depending on need. All changes to vaccine sites are updated on the website so check back frequently.
- Check each vaccine site to see if there are appointments available.
- Supply is limited, and you may not be able to book an appointment right away. Keep checking back.

You will need the following information:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Insurance (if you have it)

## Transportation

**Check transportation options before you go.**

Muni and Paratransit are free for anyone traveling to and from COVID-19 vaccine appointments. SFMTA is also providing additional access to taxi service for those using the Essential Trip Card.
