What is the San Francisco Cultural Districts Program?

San Francisco's Cultural Districts are places distinguished by unique social and historical associations with historically marginalized cultural groups. While they have physical boundaries and significant spaces, the districts are primarily identified by the people who live, work and play there and the activities that occur within them, including commerce, services, arts, events, and social practices.

The program intends to enable the associated residents, businesses, non-profits, community arts and educational institutions to live, work and prosper within the city. Each Cultural District is led by a community-based group with an executive director, an advisory body, plus robust community engagement.





This Resolution was drafted by the American Indian Cultural District and Department of Health (DPH) in partnership with FHAAI, NAHC, ARO, CCUIH, and AICC to address the concerns around American Indian data, health disparities, and encourage meaningful partnerships with American Indian organizations.
