## JAM to BAM Agenda Setting Criteria:

Upon receipt of a JAM to BAM permit application, the Deputy Director, or their designee, shall review the application and determine that the application will be on the *regular permit agenda* when the proposed application has <u>any</u> of the following characteristics:

- A change or enhancement to existing programming plans. Examples include, but are not limited to, requesting increased hours of outdoor entertainment and/or amplified sound, or changing the location of the permitted activity; or
- 2. EC Staff receive neighborhood opposition in response to the permit application; or
- 3. Unresolved compliance issues with current JAM permit conditions. This includes recent unmitigated Notices of Violation or Citations. Please note: applicants with historical compliance issues may be added to the *consent agenda* if the applicant has since taken steps to mitigate these issues and has proven compliance with JAM permit conditions at follow-up EC site visits; or
- 4. If the Director, or their designee, determines that the application warrants further review by the Entertainment Commission.

Alternatively, upon receipt of a JAM to BAM permit application, the Deputy Director, or their designee, shall review the application and determine that the application will be on the *consent permit agenda* when the proposed application has <u>all</u> of the following characteristics:

- 1. Brick and mortar permit application proposes the same outdoor programming as the JAM permit currently allows. This includes type of activation (amplified sound and/or entertainment), location of programming, and hours of proposed activity; and
- EC Staff do not receive neighborhood opposition in response to the permit application;
- 3. The business holds an existing ongoing JAM permit that is in good-standing. Good-standing means there are no current compliance issues including no active Notices of Violation or Citations. Please note: applicants with historical compliance issues may be added to the *consent agenda* if the applicant has since taken steps to mitigate these issues and has proven compliance with JAM permit conditions at follow-up EC site visits.
