



Certification Tip: Request a Threshold Check

If you are given a 1 year certification due to your firm's five year average of gross receipts being close to the next size category threshold, you are eligible for a threshold check certification review. When your firm is seeking recertification, you have the option to request a full recertification to try to obtain a 3-year certification or a threshold check where you submit tax returns only. CMD staff may issue 1 or 2 additional years for a threshold check certification.

What is a Micro Set-Aside Contract?

All awarding city departments have a yearly goal for a percentage of contracts that must be set aside for micro-LBEs. Micro set-aside contracts are generally smaller dollar contracts. Only certified San Francisco micro LBEs may bid on these contracts.

LBEs Access to Early Retention Release on Construction Contracts

Did you know that Chapter 6.22(j) of the San Francisco Administrative Code allows LBEs early retention release on construction projects? Primes can submit a letter to the awarding department requesting early release of retention on your behalf if your work on the project is complete. Talk to the Contract Compliance Officer assigned to your contract for more information.
