# **Contract Monitoring Policy**

This policy outlines foundational monitoring requirements that City departments must follow when contracting with nonprofits to provide direct services to the public.

### What you should know about the policy

San Francisco relies on its nonprofit partners to deliver over \$1.5 billion in services to San Francisco residents each year. **Departments are responsible for managing and evaluating the performance of those nonprofits**. This policy sets foundational requirements for department oversight across **five areas**. It includes **required** components and **recommended** best practices, with highlights below.



#### **Performance Measures**

- Contracts must have performance measures that should typically include targets.
- There is no required number of measures, but contracts should include both **service objectives** and **outcome measures**.
- Measures should generally be consistent across contracts for the same services.



#### Reporting

- Departments must require annual reporting at a minimum, but departments may require more reporting if useful for operations.
- Departments must provide timely access to systems.



#### **Program Monitoring**

- Departments must develop standards and checklists to ensure a consistent approach across staff and nonprofits.
- At minimum, departments must monitor each contract annually; this should be a site visit at least once during the contract term.
- Results must be communicated timely.



#### **Ongoing Engagement**

- Departments must **regularly engage** contractors through operational meetings, visits or trainings.
- Departments must visit program locations annually.



#### **Department Policies & Procedures**

 Because departments have different programming and operational needs, oversight practices will differ too.
Departments should develop their own policies and procedures aligned to this policy.

Across all areas, departments must **communicate requirements during contract negotiation.** 

## This policy applies to:

- ✓ All City departments that contract with nonprofits
- Nonprofit contracts for direct services to the public
- Nonprofit contracts valued at \$200k or more per year

## This policy does not apply to:

- X Deliverables-based nonprofit contracts
- Contracts for services for the department

#### **Implementation**

- Departments must develop policies by June 30, 2025
- Departments must update contracts executed or amended after June 30, 2025
- Policy includes detailed implementation guidance
