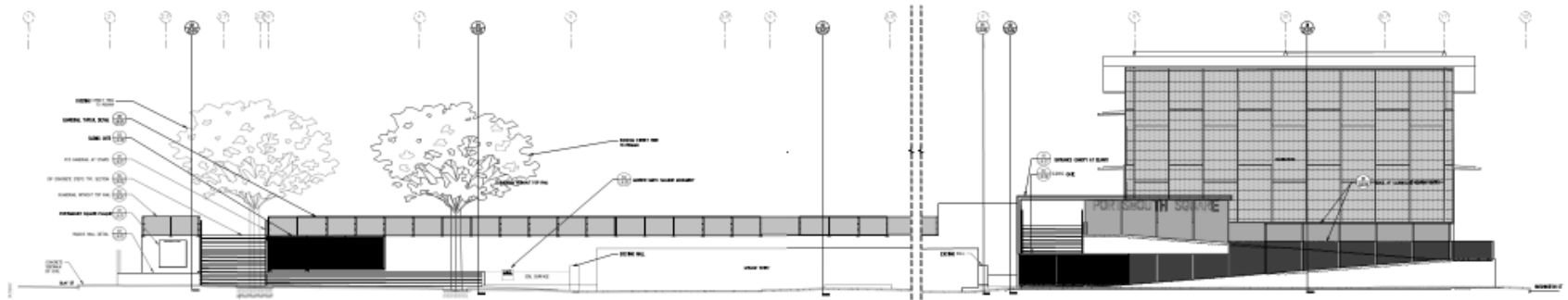
Commission Comments:

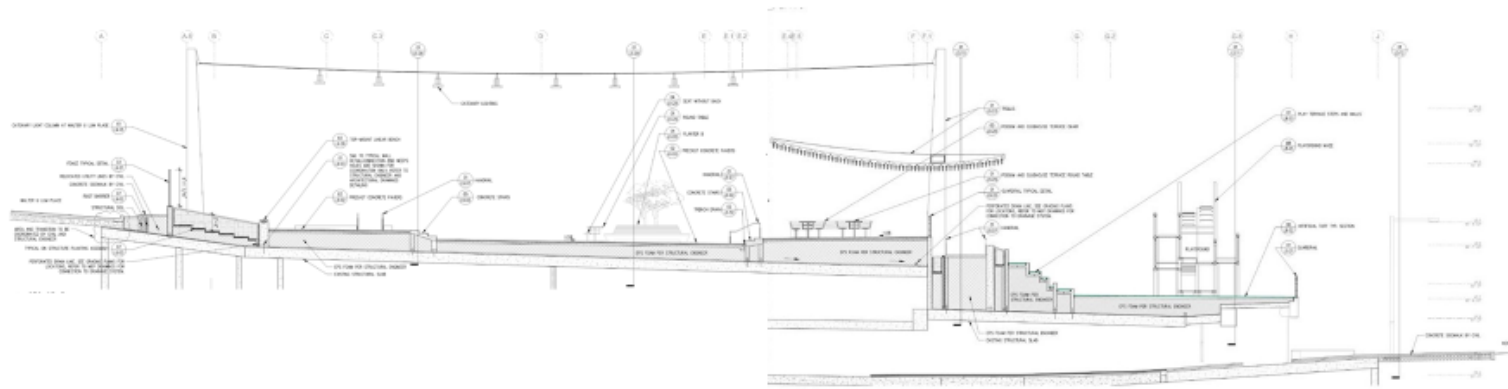

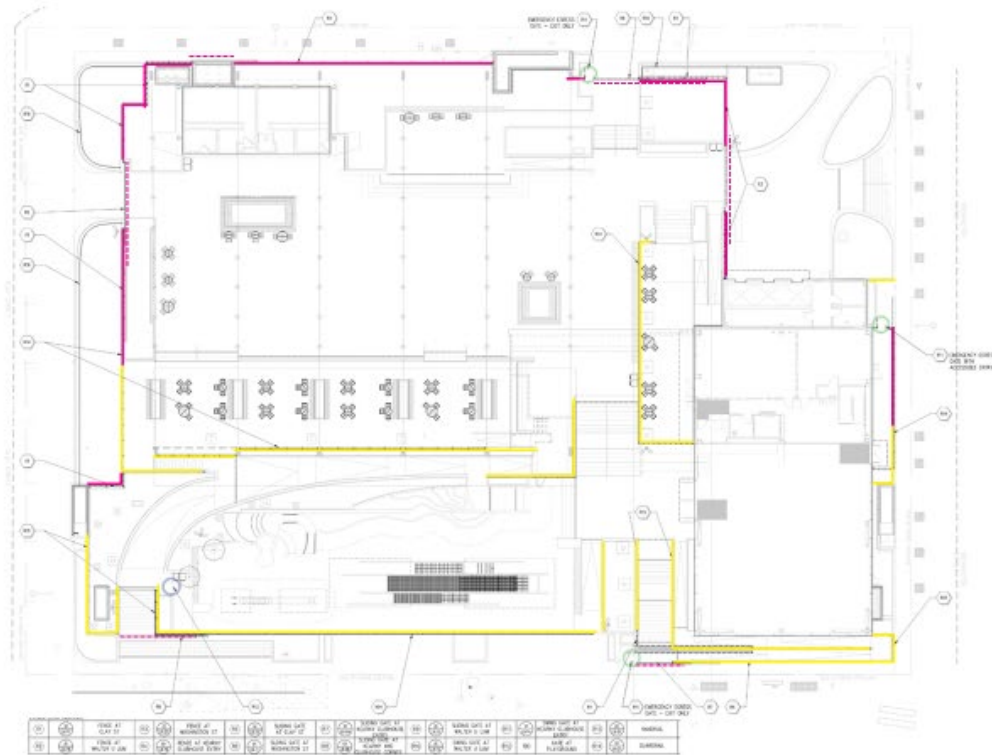




SEC 01 KEARNY STREET SECTION

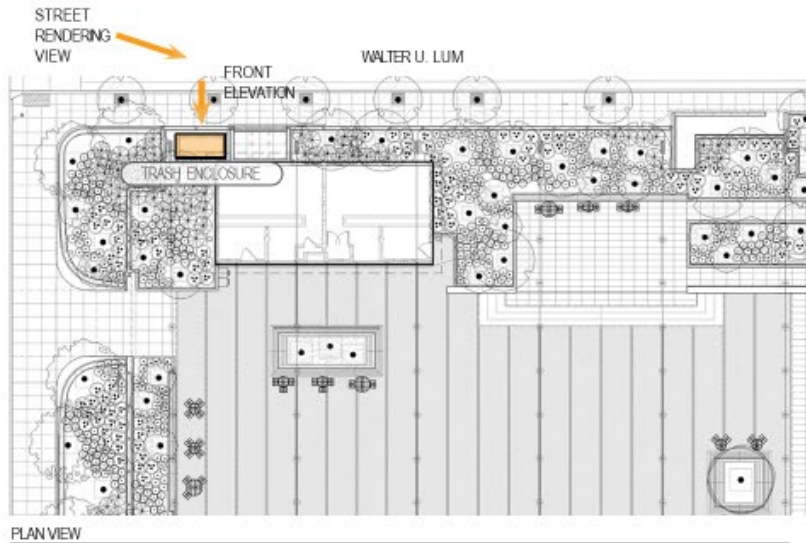

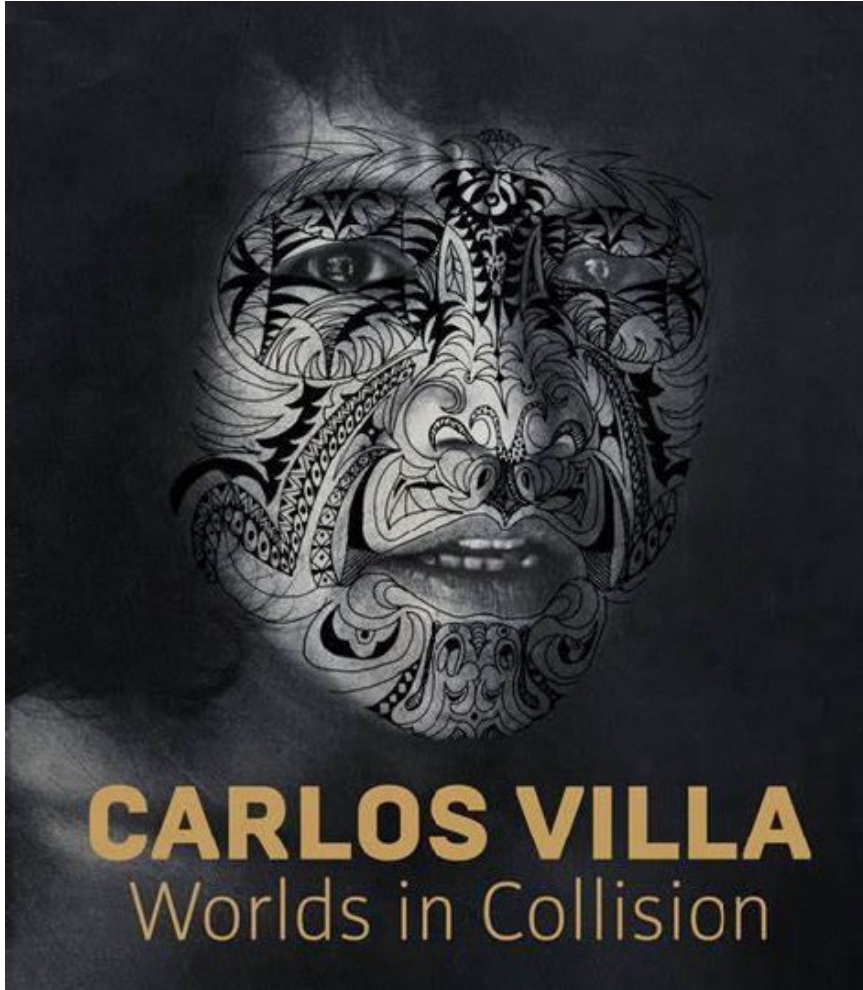

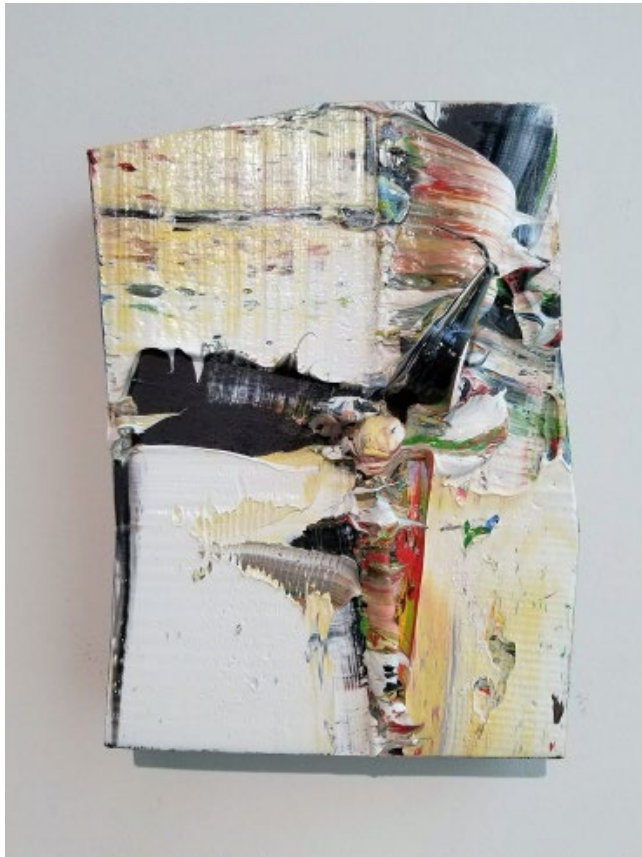
