BUSINESS DESCRIPTION

Glen Park Chiropractic is a medical business offering chiropractic services and treatment, opened originally by Dr. Andrew Sokolsky in 1987 at 2 Monterey Boulevard. The business offers advanced, high quality chiropractic care to help individuals achieve better overall health. Glen Park Chiropractic's main services focus on providing pain relief, optimizing spine health, and treatment without the use of drugs or surgery. Glen Park Chiropractic has been owned and operated solely by Dr. Sokolsky for the entirety of its 35 years in business. He has treated over 4,000 patients since opening the business.

Glen Park Chiropractic is one of the longest running businesses in the Glen Park neighborhood. When the business was first opened, it was known as Andrew's Chiropractic Care in order to be listed toward the front of the phone book. In 1999, Dr. Sokolsky changed the name to its current name, "Glen Park Chiropractic." Despite the change in name, the quality of services and care offered by Glen Park Chiropractic has remained the same, while continuously evolving to incorporate the latest technology and techniques in chiropractic care. Some of the specific services include providing patients general health advice; specialized treatment for automobile accident recovery; and advice pertaining to health insurance, injury recovery, spinal alignment and health, pain relief, and recovery solutions without the use of surgery or drugs. Further, Dr. Sokolsky uses the Activator Chiropractic, a type of manual manipulation treatment used by chiropractors to treat various types of back and neck pain, using a low-force impulse at specific points on the back and neck. Glen Park Chiropractic generates specific treatment plans for each patient, focusing on the patient's unique health needs and issues.

The interior of Glen Park Chiropractic features an office with a reception area and waiting room for the business' patients and a single examination room. The exterior features a royal blue awning reading, "Glen Park Chiropractic" and a set of divided lite windows. Glen Park Chiropractic has remained an anchor in the Glen Park commercial corridor since opening in 1987, supporting neighboring businesses and offering friendly and quality care to all in Glen Park. Glen Park Chiropractic's patients are primarily from the Glen Park neighborhood, but patients from all over the city and Bay Area have been treated at the business. Glen Park Chiropractic has continuously given back to the Glen Park neighborhood, including supporting and promoting its fellow Glen Park businesses, participating in neighborhood events such as the Glen Park Neighborhood Festival, and attending meetings on neighborhood issues and safety. Further, Dr. Sokolsky continued to see patients and provide chiropractic treatment throughout the Coronavirus pandemic, demonstrating his and Glen Park Chiropractic's lasting commitment to its patients. Lastly, Dr. Sokolsky is an active member of the Glen Park Merchants Association.

It is my pleasure to nominate Glen Park Chiropractic, located at 2 Monterey Blvd., as a San Francisco Legacy Business. Originally called Andrew's Chiropractic Care, Glen Park Chiropractic was opened by Dr. Andrew Sokolsky in 1987, and has been located at its current location just one block from the Glen Park BART station for nearly 35 years. Over this time, "Dr. Andrew" has treated some 4,000 patients, improving the lives of generations of Glen Park and San Francisco residents by providing critical nonsurgery, drug-free care for patients who often are not able to receive such care from their primary medical facilities.

Glen Park Chiropractic is one of the longest-running businesses in Glen Park and has been a prime example of the kind of locally-owned neighborhood serving health service business that has become increasingly hard to find in recent years. The business has been continuously operated as a sole proprietorship for nearly four decades, with Dr. Sokolsky donning a mask and gloves to continue providing in-person care throughout the coronavirus pandemic. Dr. Sokolsky has been a member of the Glen Park Merchants Association since 1987 and he has participated in numerous community events over the years like the Glen Park Neighborhood Festival.

Glen Park Chiropractic is deserving of the City's recognition and appreciation as a Legacy Business, and I urge the Office of Small Business to proceed with this nomination.

GLEN PARK CHIROPRACTIC Section 4: Written Historical Narrative

CRITERION 1

a. Provide a short history of the business from the date the business opened in San Francisco to the present day, including the ownership history. For businesses with multiple locations, include the history of the original location in San Francisco (including whether it was the business's founding and or headquartered location) and the opening dates and locations of all other locations.

Glen Park Chiropractic, located at 2 Monterey Blvd. in the Glen Park neighborhood was opened by Dr. Andrew Sokolsky, D.C., in September of 1987.

The business was originally called Andrew's Chiropractic Care because the internet didn't yet exist yet, and Andrew wanted to be toward the front of the phone book. Many patients called Dr. Sokolsky "Dr. Andrew." The business named changed when people started using the internet more instead of the phone book to find a service they were looking for. The name Glen Park Chiropractic was registered on December 5, 1999. Both names have been legally maintained for the practice.

The practice has always been located at the street-level storefront at 2 Monterey Blvd. at Diamond Street, one block from Glen Park BART.

The business has always been a sole proprietorship. Andrew has treated about 4,000 patients over 35 years and have been credited with saving patients' lives who reported to his office without being properly diagnosed by the medical facilities that originally treated them. Andrew also assisted many patients in getting better without surgery, which they would have required had they not received drug-free chiropractic care.

Glen Park Chiropractic has been a member of the Glen Park Merchants Association since 1987, and Andrew has been the treating chiropractor for many of his fellow merchants. It has been his honor to serve so many members of the Glen Park community and the city at large.

b. Describe any circumstances that required the business to cease operations in San Francisco for more than six months?

The business has never ceased operating since September 1987. Since the business was founded, Andrew has missed only a few days because of illness when he needed to be in the hospital to have a stent put in one of his coronary arteries a few years ago. Andrew had to be talked out of leaving the hospital by his doctor, as he is very dedicated to serving his patients.

Andrew worked every day throughout the coronavirus pandemic of 2020-2022, with a mask and gloves, doing over 1,800 in-person patient treatments.

c. Is the business a family-owned business? If so, give the generational history of the business.

The business is not "a family-owned business." It has always been a sole proprietorship owned by Andrew Sokolsky.

d. Describe the ownership history when the business ownership is not the original owner or a family-owned business.

Andrew Sokolsky has been the original owner since the business was founded.

e. Glen Park Chiropractic has contributed to the stability, beautification, and continuity of the Glen Park neighborhood. Only one other business in the neighborhood, (Dalere's Beauty Salon), that has been open for as long as Glen Park Chiropractic. The business is an active member of the Glen Park Merchants Association and supports other businesses in the neighborhood.

b. Is the business (or has been) associated with significant events in the neighborhood, the city, or the business industry?

The business has participated in neighborhood events including the Glen Park Neighborhood Festival. Business owner Dr. Andrew Sokolsky has spoken before the Glen Park Merchants Association numerous times since 1987. He has also participated in meetings about neighborhood safety and other neighborhood issues.

c. Has the business ever been referenced in an historical context? Such as in a business trade publication, media, or historical documents?

Glen Park Chiropractic was featured in a United States Postal Service magazine when Andrew spoke to Postal Service employees at the Diamond Heights Post Office about safe lifting techniques.

d. Is the business associated with a significant or historical person?

Andrew's daughter was born and raised in San Francisco, and still lives in our great city. She considers him to be quite significant. Andrew can think of no greater honor. Other than that, Glen Park Chiropractic is not associated with a significant or historical person.

e. How does the business demonstrate its commitment to the community?

Glen Park Chiropractic has been available to treat people who live in the neighborhood almost every day of the year for 35 years. That's nearly 13,000 days with only 3 sick days and far too few vacations. Andrew consults with merchants and anyone else who wants advice. Recently, he spoke with a neighbor of the office and saved her from a possible heart attack or stroke by advising her about her blood pressure.

f. Provide a description of the community the business serves.

Glen Park Chiropractic serves the thousands of people who live in Glen Park, and anyone else in San Francisco or the Bay Area who might need chiropractic services. Dr. Andrew Sokolsky is also an auto accident specialist. He has treated over 1,000 people who have been injured in automobile accidents. He will answer all of your questions, help you deal with insurance, and most importantly, help you recover from your injuries. His goal is to get you back to where you were before the accident, as quickly as possible.

g. Is the business associated with a culturally significant building/structure/site/object/interior?

The business is not associated with a culturally significant building, structure, site, object, or interior.

h. How would the community be diminished if the business were to be sold, relocated, shut down, etc.?

If the business were to close, the neighborhood would be without a dedicated chiropractor who cares about the people who live here. There are unknown subtle loses when you can't "walk down the block" to get treatment, feel better, and consult with a caring doctor.

Glen Park Chiropractic has expertise in providing relief from discomfort and pain, getting the spine to function optimally, and maintaining spinal health. Dr. Andrew Sokolsky is a specialist in Activator Chiropractic, which is safe, low-force, and very effective. Andrew has treated over 4,000 patients and saved at least four people's lives by sending people back to the Emergency Room or their medical doctors after they had been released by medical facilities with unrecognized cancers and fractures. This is exciting to him, and more than exciting to the people whose lives who were saved, and to their families.

Business Description

Glen Park Chiropractic is a medical business offering chiropractic services and treatment, opened originally by Dr. Andrew Sokolsky in 1987 at 2 Monterey Boulevard. Dr. Sokolsky opened Glen Park Chiropractic with the intention of offering advanced, high quality chiropractic care, and to help individuals achieve better overall health. Glen Park Chiropractic's main services focus on providing pain relief, optimizing spine health, and treatment without the use of drugs or surgery. Glen Park Chiropractic has been owned and operated solely by Dr. Sokolsky for the entirety of its 35 years in business. Dr. Sokolsky has treated over 4,000 patients since opening Glen Park Chiropractic.

Glen Park Chiropractic first opened in the Glen Park neighborhood and has remained there since, making it one of the longest running businesses in the Glen Park neighborhood. When the business was first opened, it was known as Andrew's Chiropractic Care, in order to be listed toward the front of the phone book. In 1999, Dr. Sokolsky changed the name to its current name, "Glen Park Chiropractic". Despite the change in name, the quality of services and care offered by Glen Park Chiropractic has remained the same, while continuously evolving to

incorporate the latest technology and techniques in chiropractic care. Some of the specific services currently offered by Glen Park Chiropractic include providing patients general health advice, specialized treatment for automobile accident recovery, advice pertaining to health insurance, injury recovery, spinal alignment and health, pain relief, and recovery solutions without the use of surgery or drugs. Further, Dr. Sokolsky uses the Activator Chiropractic, a type of manual manipulation treatment used by chiropractors to treat various types of back and neck pain, using a low-force impulse at specific points on the back and neck. Glen Park Chiropractic generates specific treatment plans for each patient, focusing on the patient's unique health needs and issues.

Not only have the chiropractic services remained largely the same for the last 35 years, but the interior and exterior of the business has remained similar in appearance as well. Glen Park Chiropractic has remained in the same space across the street from the Glen Park BART station since opening in 1987. Its interior space features an office with a reception area and waiting room for the business's patients and a single examination room. The exterior features a royal blue awning reading, "Glen Park Chiropractic" and a set of divided lite windows.

Glen Park Chiropractic has remained an anchor in the Glen Park commercial corridor since opening in 1987, supporting neighboring businesses and offering friendly and quality care to all in Glen Park. Glen Park Chiropractic's patients are primarily from the Glen Park neighborhood, but patients from all over the City and Bay Area have been treated at Glen Park Chiropractic.

Glen Park Chiropractic has continuously given back to the Glen Park neighborhood, including supporting and promoting its fellow Glen Park businesses, participating in neighborhood events such as the Glen Park Neighborhood Festival, and attending meetings on neighborhood issues and safety. Further, Dr. Sokolsky continued to see patients and provide chiropractic treatment throughout the Coronavirus pandemic, demonstrating his and Glen Park Chiropractic's lasting commitment to its patients. Lastly, Dr. Sokolsky is an active member of the Glen Park Merchants Association.

The business's primary location at 2 Monterey Boulevard is a Category C (No Resource Present / Not Age Eligible) structure on the north side of Monterey Boulevard between Joost Avenue and Diamond Street in the Glen Park neighborhood. It is within the Glen Park NCT (Neighborhood Commercial Transit) Zoning District and a 40-X Height and Bulk District. It is located within the Glen Park Planning Area.
