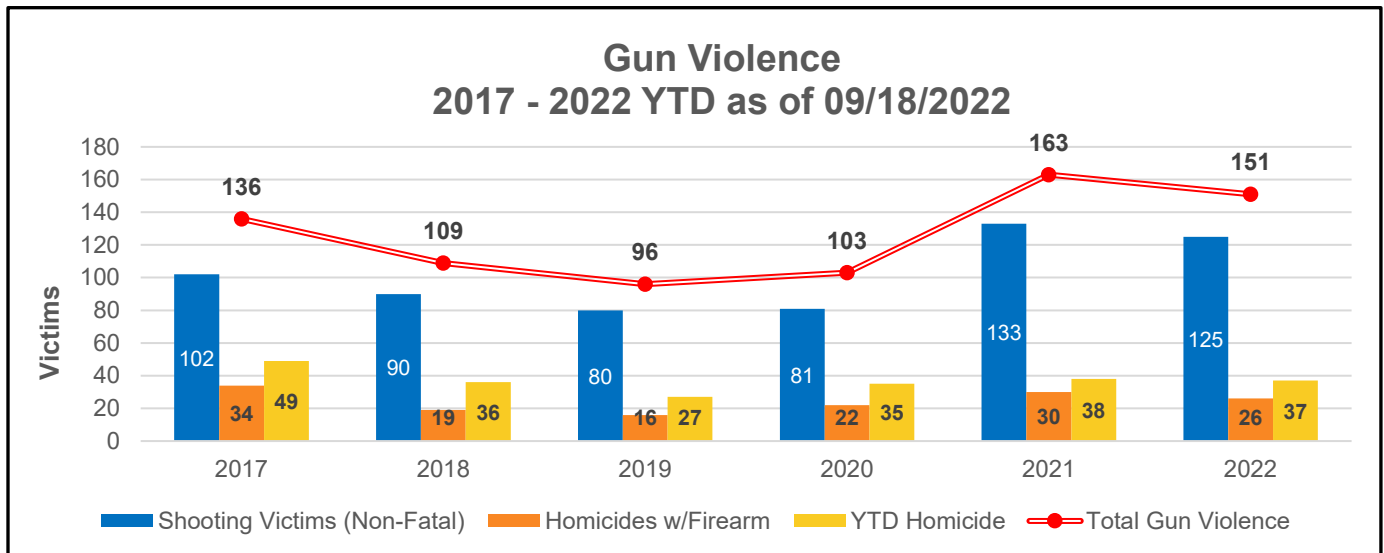

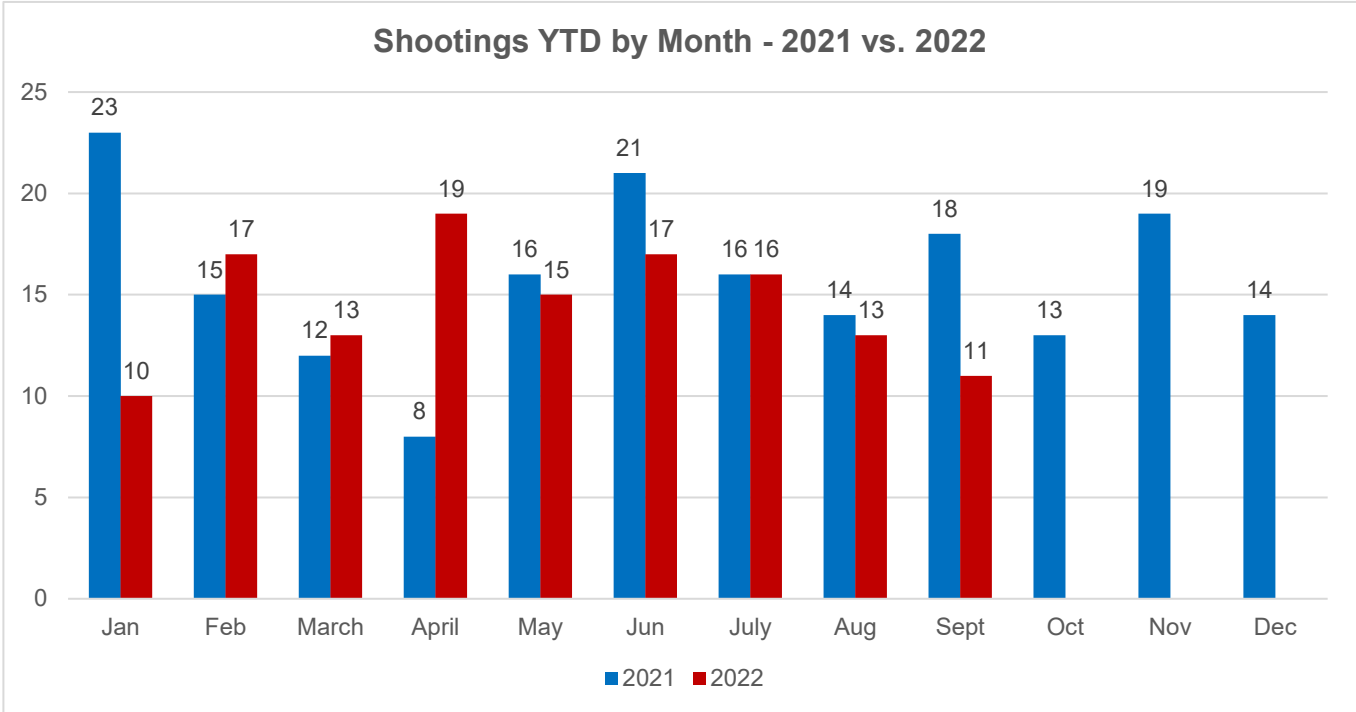
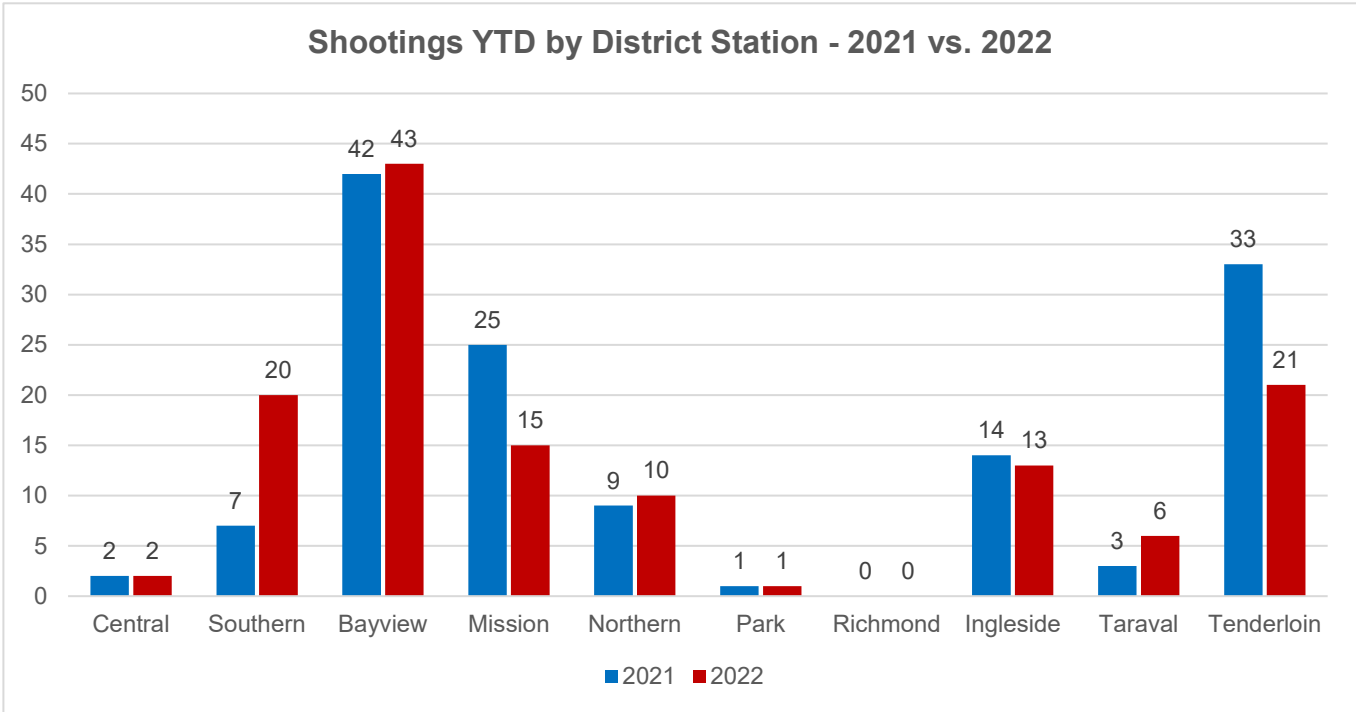
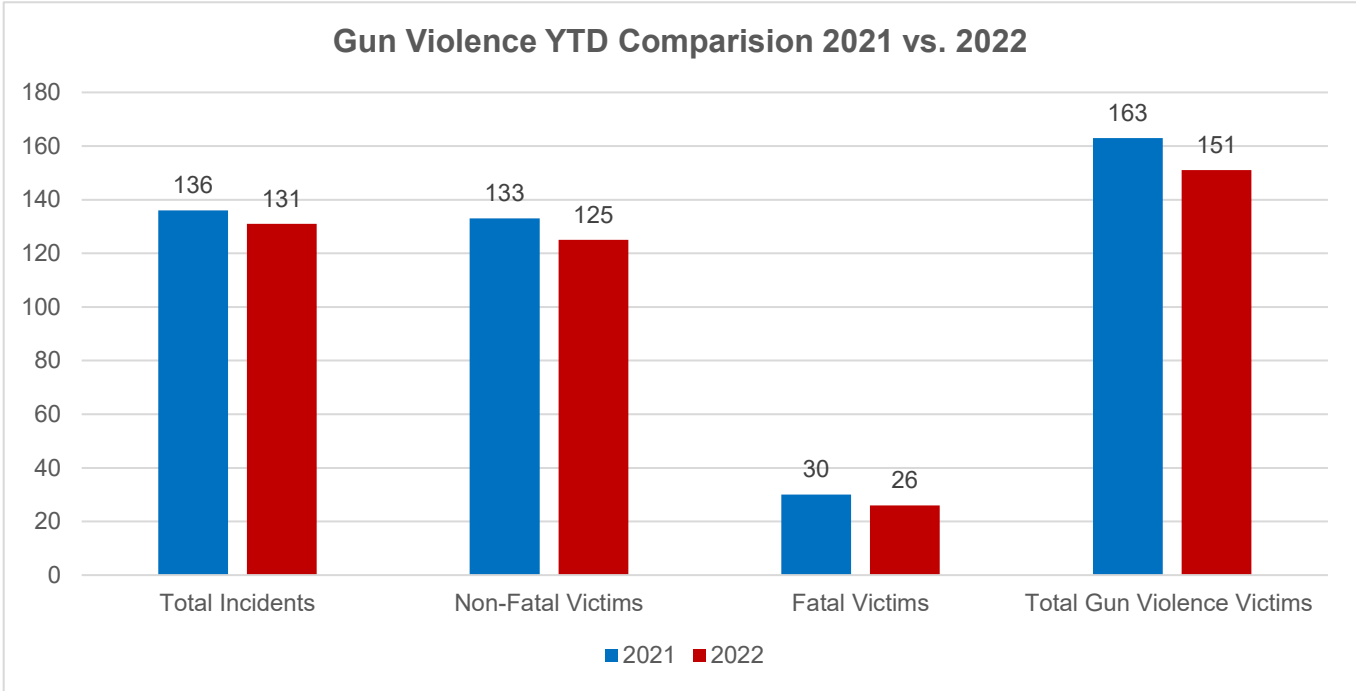

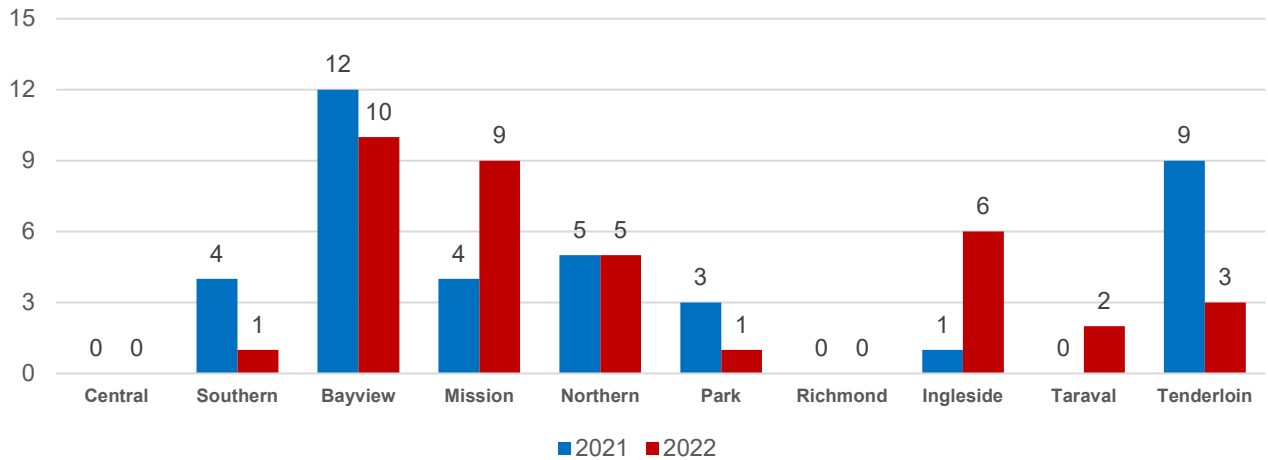
GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 7% compared to 2021

- There were 5 shooting incidents causing injuries to 6 individuals for the week ending 09/18/22
 - There are a total of 131 incidents resulting in 151 victims YTD
- There was 1 homicide incident the week ending on 09/18/2022
 - Please note – a homicide occurred outside the reporting period which will be included in next week's statistics
 - There are 37 homicides YTD with 26 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 61%

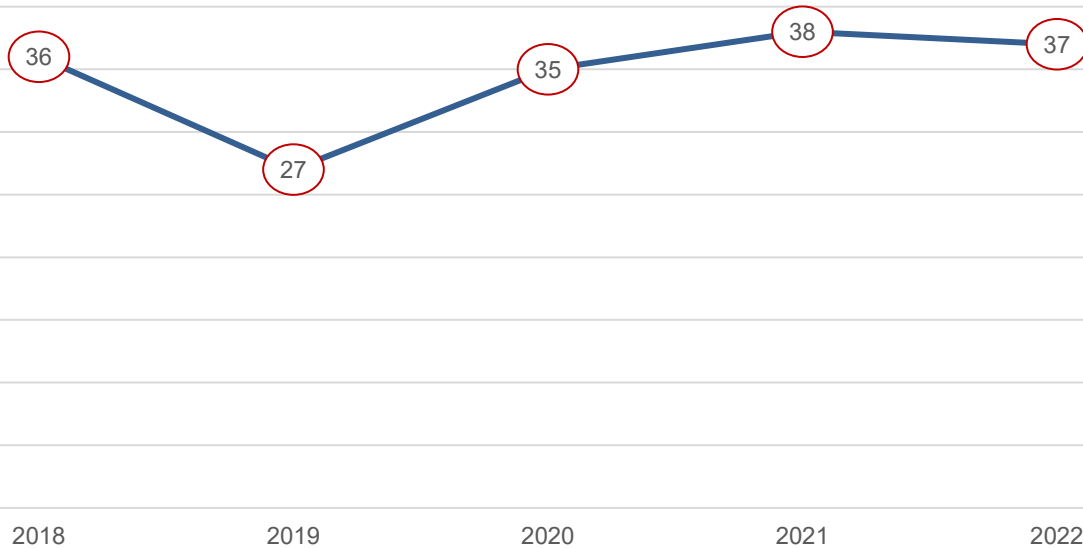
