Options for Secure Youth Treatment Facility Site(s)

Potential vote options for the subcommittee:

- 1. Vote to use Juvenile Hall as SF's interim SYTF and to revise plan once City leadership makes decisions re: SF's place of detention.
- 2. Vote to use Juvenile Hall as SF's interim SYTF and to revise SYTF plan once City leadership makes decisions re: SF's place of detention; to recommend to City leadership to consider co-locating SF's SYTF and SF's future place of detention; and that regardless this place should be healing-centered, family-centered, community-connected, and culturally responsive.
- 3. Vote to use Juvenile Hall as SF's interim SYTF; to recommend to City leadership that SYTF and SF's future place of detention are co-located going forward; and that this place should be healing-centered, family-centered, community-connected, and culturally responsive.
 - Proposed motion language:

San Francisco shall use Juvenile Hall as its interim Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF) until the City's future place of detention is identified and implemented; and, at that time, we recommend to City leadership that the SYTF be colocated with San Francisco's place of detention going forward; and we recommend that this place be healing-centered, family-centered, community-connected, and culturally responsive.

- 4. Vote to use Juvenile Hall as SF's interim SYTF; and to develop a new separate SYTF (either new construction or renovation).
- 5. Vote to send all secure commits to Out Of County SYTFs (once contracts are executed).

In addition, the group needs to consider whether to offer Out Of County SYTFs as a choice to SF youth:

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In addition, the group needs to consider whether to offer Out Of County SYTFs as a <u>choice</u> to SF youth:

- SF could be the only option;
- SF could be the default/primary option with Out Of County SYTFs as possible alternatives;
- SF could be one of a menu of options.

Finally, the group needs to consider whether to offer SF's SYTF to other jurisdictions.
