- Subcommittee votes to approve plan; votes to approve funding priorities for Year One & Year Two of funding; submits plan to OYCR

- Prepare Requests for Proposals for Credible Messenger Life Coaches and Whole Family Support/Direct Funding

- Discuss Step Up/Down Programs, and Out of County Vetting Process
- Release, score, and select grantees for Credible Messenger Life Coaches and Whole Family Support

- Release RFPs for Additional Programming
- Planning period for new life coach and family support grantees; programming and services begin

- Year One & Two JJRBG programs and services are delivered
- Planning for FY 2023-24 funding; update DJJ Realignment Plan as juvenile hall replacement is determined
- Review of first full year of DJJ Realignment and SYTF

# Step Down Alternatives Update

- We can set up a Less Restrictive Alternatives Workgroup as long as it does not include a majority of subcommittee members
- Other stakeholders have indicated their interest in joining the workgroup which is encouraged

# Out of County SYTF Vetting Process

- Invite representatives from other county to DJJ Realignment Subcommittee meeting to provide info about their SYTF program and provide responses to our questions/criteria
- Representatives of DJJ Realignment Subcommittee complete site visits at out of county SYTF program and report back to subcommittee

# Criteria for Out of County SYTF Review

- **Alignment with subcommittee values**
  - How can facility demonstrate that it is healing-centered, family-centered, community-connected, and culturally responsive?
  - How does county collaborate with nonprofit partners?
- **Geographic location**
  - Does county provide transportation for families? If not, will SF?
- **Populations served**
  - Gender, special populations, etc.
  - Consideration of peer-to-peer dynamics of SF youth and the youth from the SYTF county and how county would respond to this
- **Custodial staff relationships with young people in the facility**
- **Facility's discipline policy**
  - Use of pepper spray and isolation

# Criteria for Out of County SYTF Review (continued)

- **Visitation policies and schedule**
  - Phone, video visits, and in person visits
- **Facility's transition protocol/plan for out of county youth**
- **Screening and suitability for individual youth for each particular SYTF program**
- **Ensure youth has this information and the opportunity to provide meaningful feedback to SF stakeholders**
