Re: COVID-19 Testing at Juvenile Hall Lobby

The Juvenile Probation Department has partnered with the California Department of Public Health to offer COVID-19 testing in the Juvenile Hall Lobby. This testing is through Primary Health and begins on Monday, October 4, 2021.

<https://my.primary.health/l/sfjuvenileprobation> or you can use your cellular telephone using the attached PDF flyer. You only need to register once and each time you test, it will take no longer than 5 minutes.

Here is some basic information about the testing program:

- Testing is required if you wish to enter Juvenile Hall. Testing is optional for staff members who work with the general public at 375 Woodside Ave.
- This program has two different types of testing: BinaxNOW (rapid antigen tests with results in under 30-minutes) and PCR tests (results in 48-72 hours). For the immediate future, we will be using BinaxNOW at the Juvenile Hall Lobby.
- Pre-registration is recommended and collects necessary information and consent.
PLEASE DO NOT REPORT INSURANCE INFORMATION. LEAVE THIS AREA BLANK AND CONTINUE WITH THE REGISTRATION PROCESS.

- All questions included in registration are required for California State public health reporting. Please note this program is free for all participants.
- Information and test results are only shared with the testing site, lab partners, and local/state health departments. It is not used for any other purposes.
- All results are shared electronically with the contact information provided during registration. **PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR CELLULAR TELEPHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL FOR NOTIFICATIONS.**

We'll be testing daily beginning at 6:30am on October 4, 2021. This is subject to change with advanced notification to improve workflow and testing efficiency.
