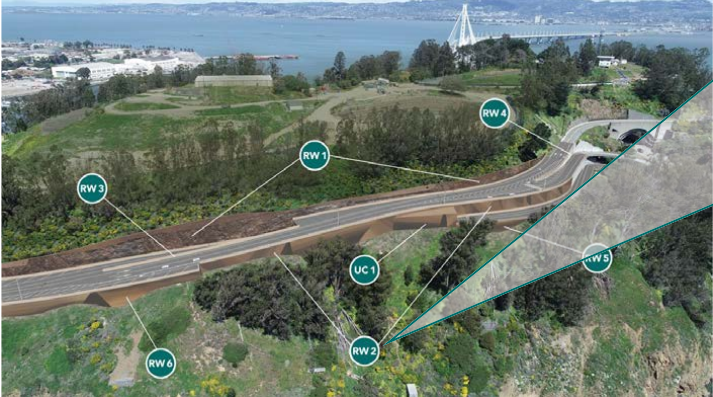
Retaining Wall 2 Design



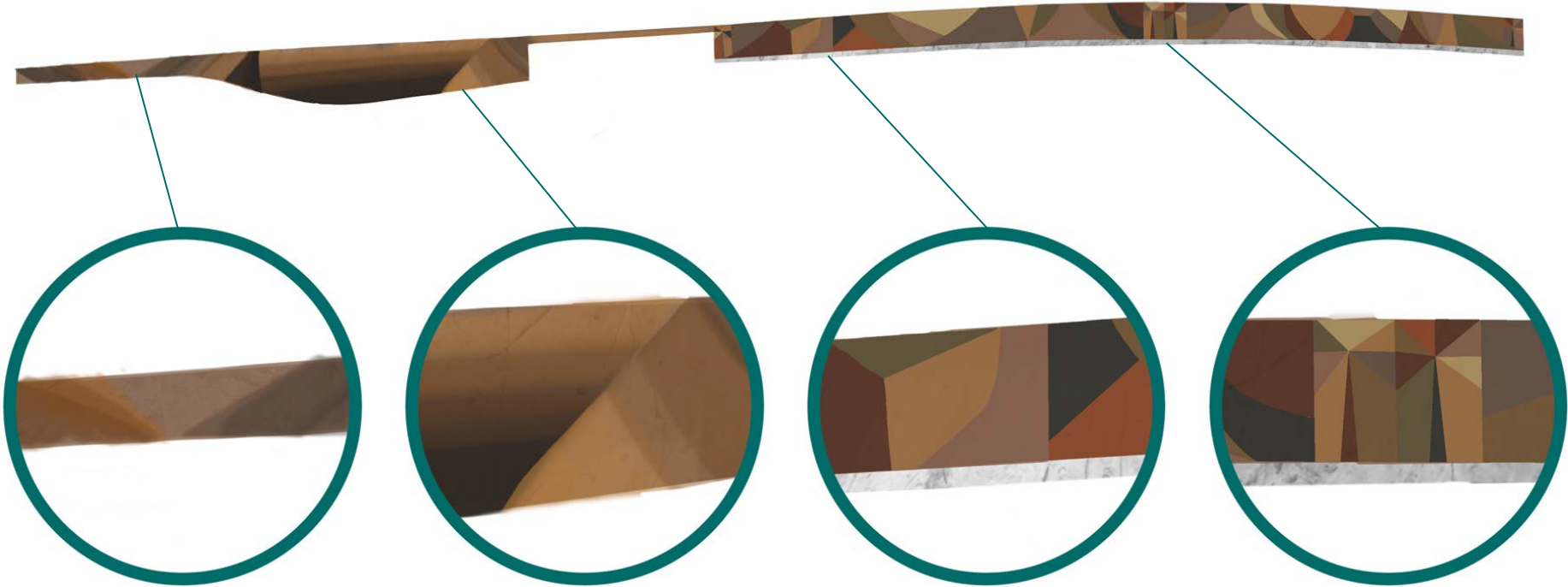
