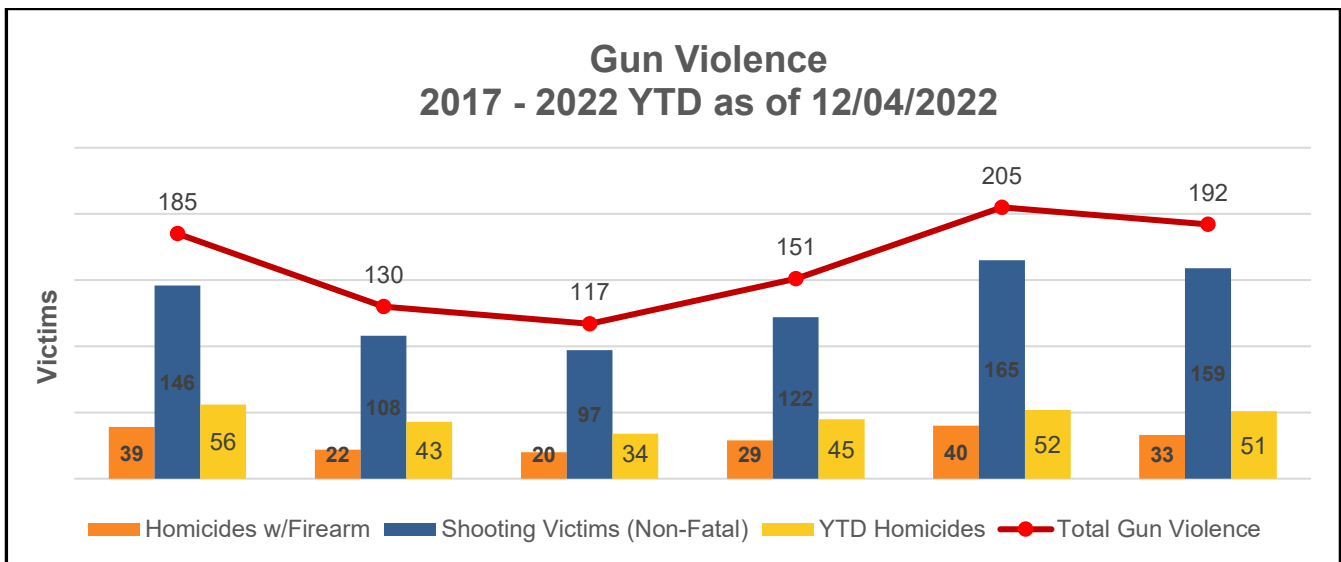

*Total Gun Violence = Non-fatal Shooting Victims + Fatal Shooting Victims

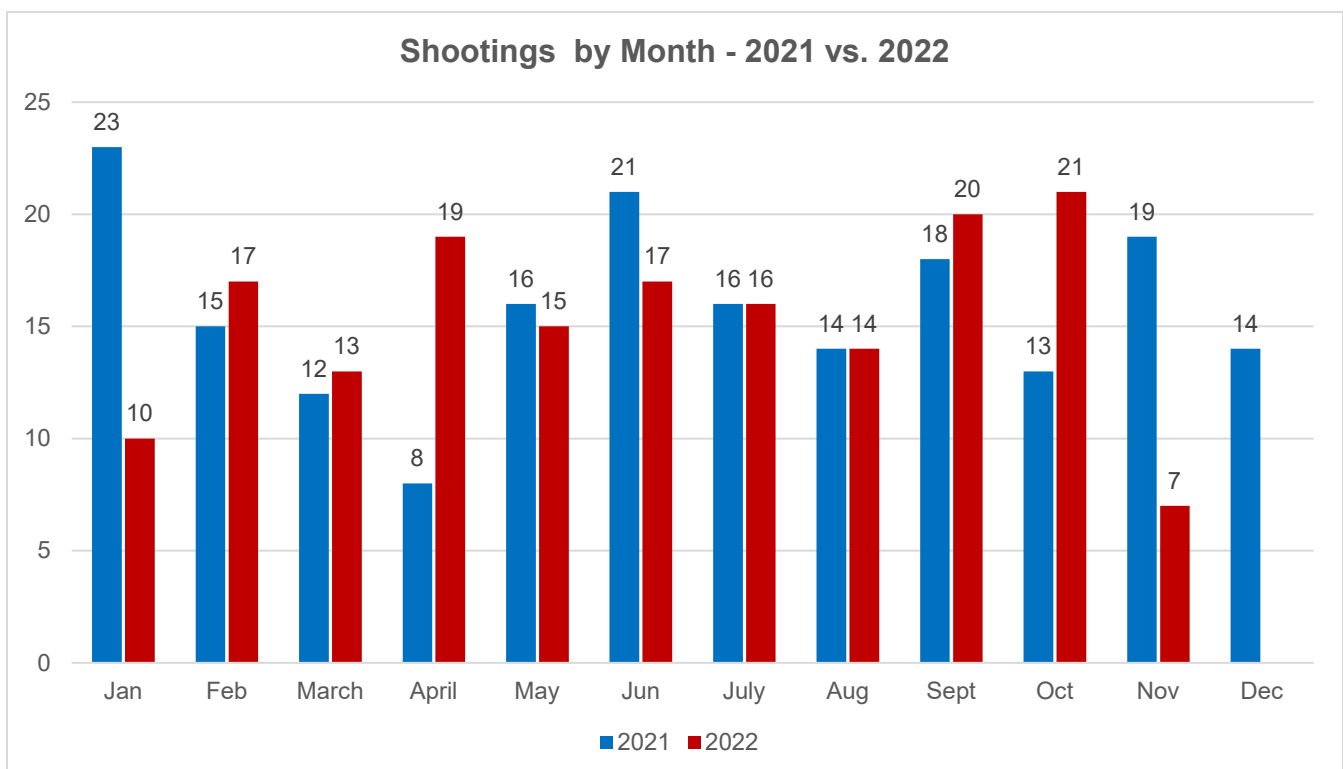
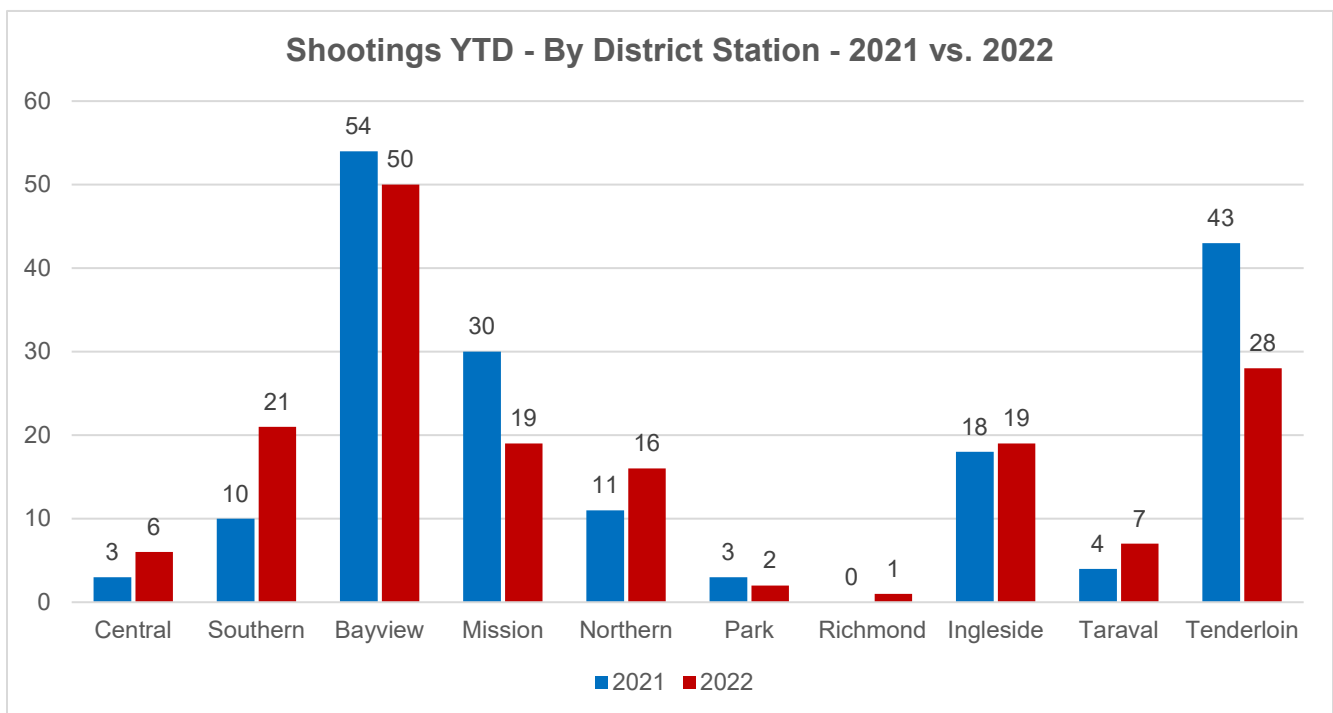
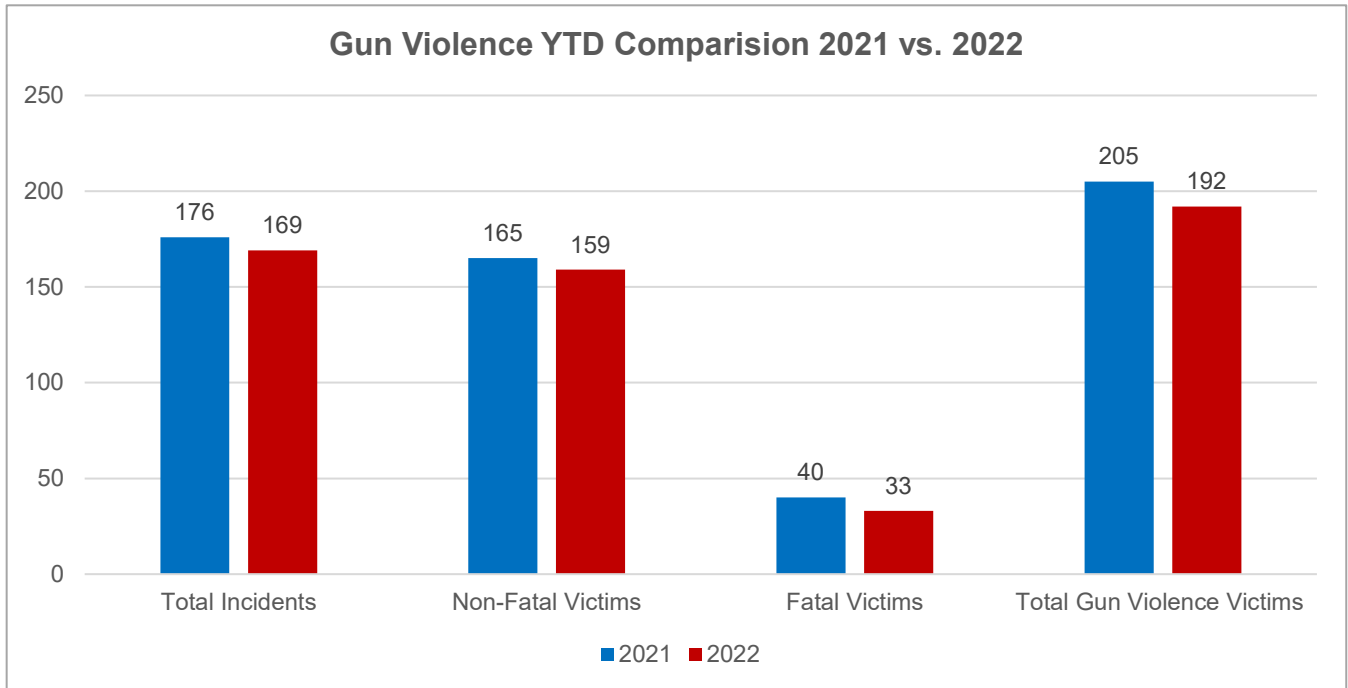

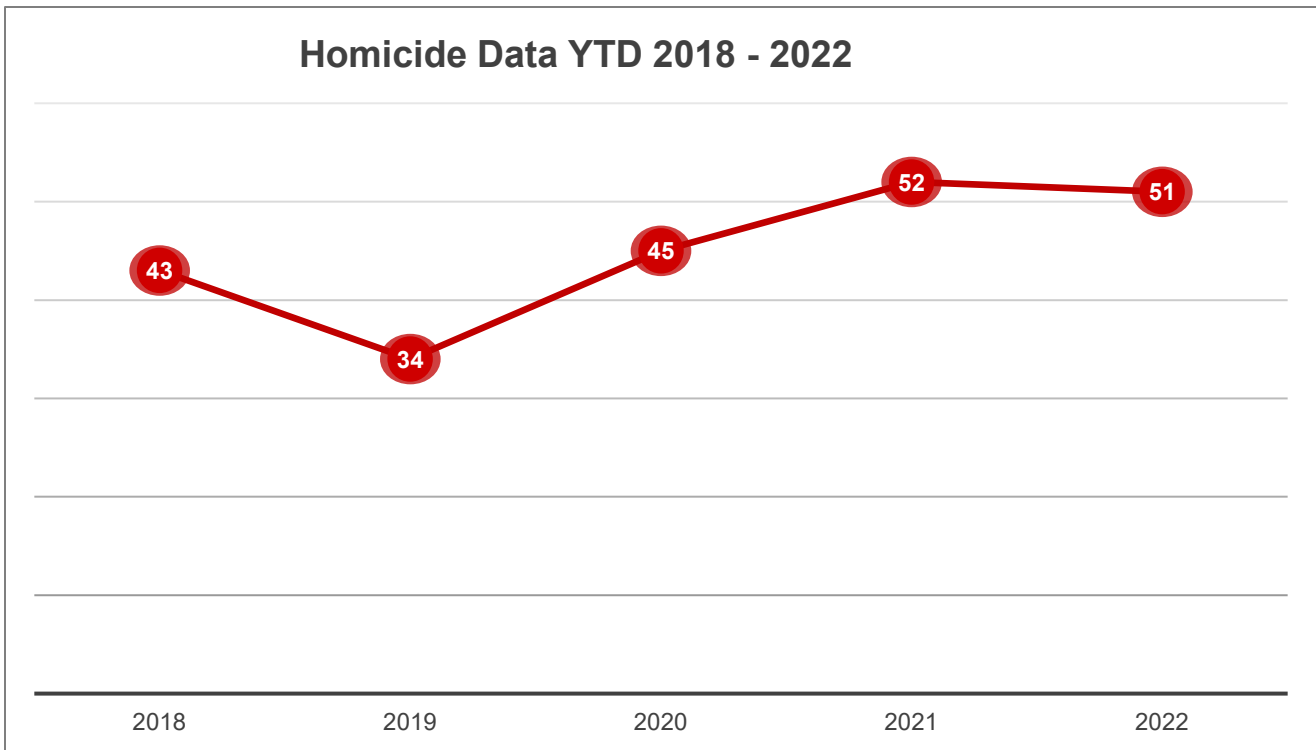
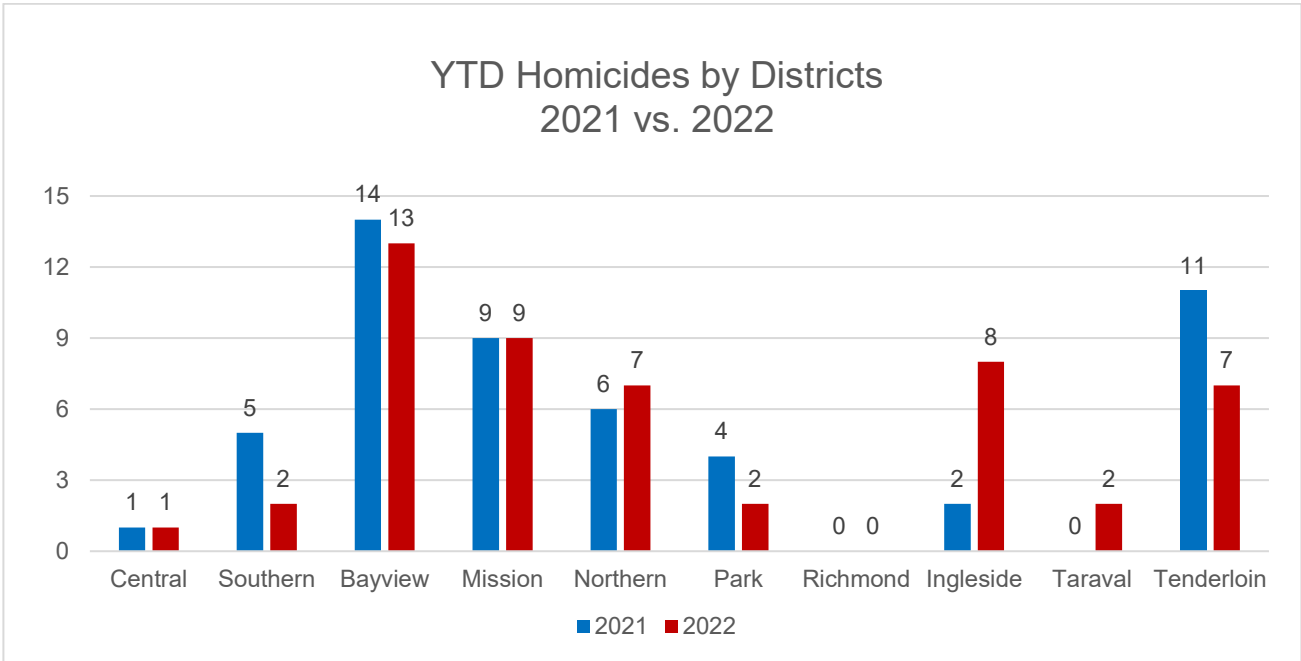
GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 6% compared to 2021

- There were no shooting incidents causing injuries to any individuals for the week ending **12/04/22**
 - There are a total of 169 incidents resulting in 192 victims
- There were no homicide incidents reported the week ending on **12/04/22**
 - There are 51 homicides YTD with 33 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 62%
