


## I POLICY

- A. Special Programs for Youth (SPY) shall provide health services to all youth detained at San Francisco's Juvenile Justice Center (JJC).
- B. SPY's Medical Director, in cooperation with SPY's Medical Director of Behavioral Health, Director of Operations and Administration of the Juvenile Probation shall:
  - 1. develop and maintain policy for health care administration;
  - 2. identify health care providers for the defined scope of services;
  - 3. establish written agreements as necessary to provide access to health care;
  - 4. develop mechanisms to assure that those agreements are properly monitored; and,
  - 5. establish systems for coordination among health care service providers.
- C. SPY's Medical Director shall be a physician, or there shall be a designated responsible physician who shall develop and implement policy in health care matters involving clinical judgments.

## II PROCEDURES

- A. SPY's Medical Director is the designated health administrator who oversees medical care of youth seen by SPY, oversees clinical supervision of medical providers and has ultimate medical decision making power.
- B. The Medical Director designates the Director of SPY for on-site administrative operations, a Nurse Practitioner for on-site medical operations, and a Medical Director of Behavioral Health for on-site mental health services.
- C. The Medical Director over-see compliance with Title 15, the San Francisco Department of Public Health policies and procedures for provision of health care, and oversees development of SPY-specific policies and procedures in health care matters to assure high quality health care and compliance with this policy.
