


I. POLICY

SPY will provide gender and developmentally appropriate medical, behavioral/mental and dental health education and disease prevention programs and individual counseling to youth at the Juvenile Justice Center. These programs will be reviewed annually and updated as necessary to meet the needs of youth at JJC.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. SPY Education shall organize providers from community based agencies with expertise in topic areas to present health education and disease prevention topics through the Woodside Learning Center Science curricula.
- B. The Director is responsible for clearance for outside groups to enter JJC with the JJC administration, coordinating with the science teacher for timing and content of presentations, and in the event of cancellations, finding alternative health educators or topics.
- C. The Director will review the topics and effectiveness of presentations at least annually and make changes in topics and presenters to assure that the content is relevant to the youth at JJC.
- D. Individual health education will be available to youth by referral via the health education referral form for drug abuse and sexual health issues. Any SPY staff may submit a health education referral form to the Health Educator who will provide health education and document in the medical record that the youth was referred and seen by a health educator.
