I. POLICY

Special Programs for Youth (SPY) personnel will not perform physical examinations of any kind (e.g.: body cavity searches), collect specimens (e.g., draw blood), take pictures, use procedures to identify the age of a youth for non-clinical reasons, or participate in any other type of clinical activity for the purpose of evidence collection for processing of charges against the detainee.

II. PROCEDURES

Should any SPY staff be asked to participate in the clinical collection of evidence from a youth, staff will refuse to do so.
