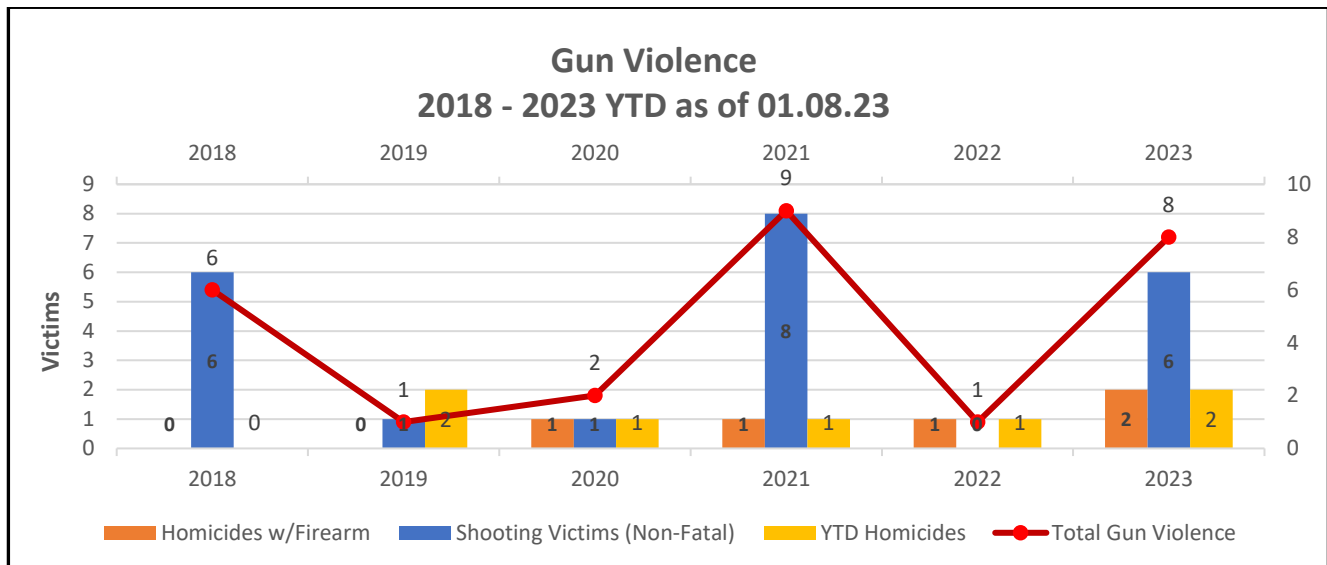

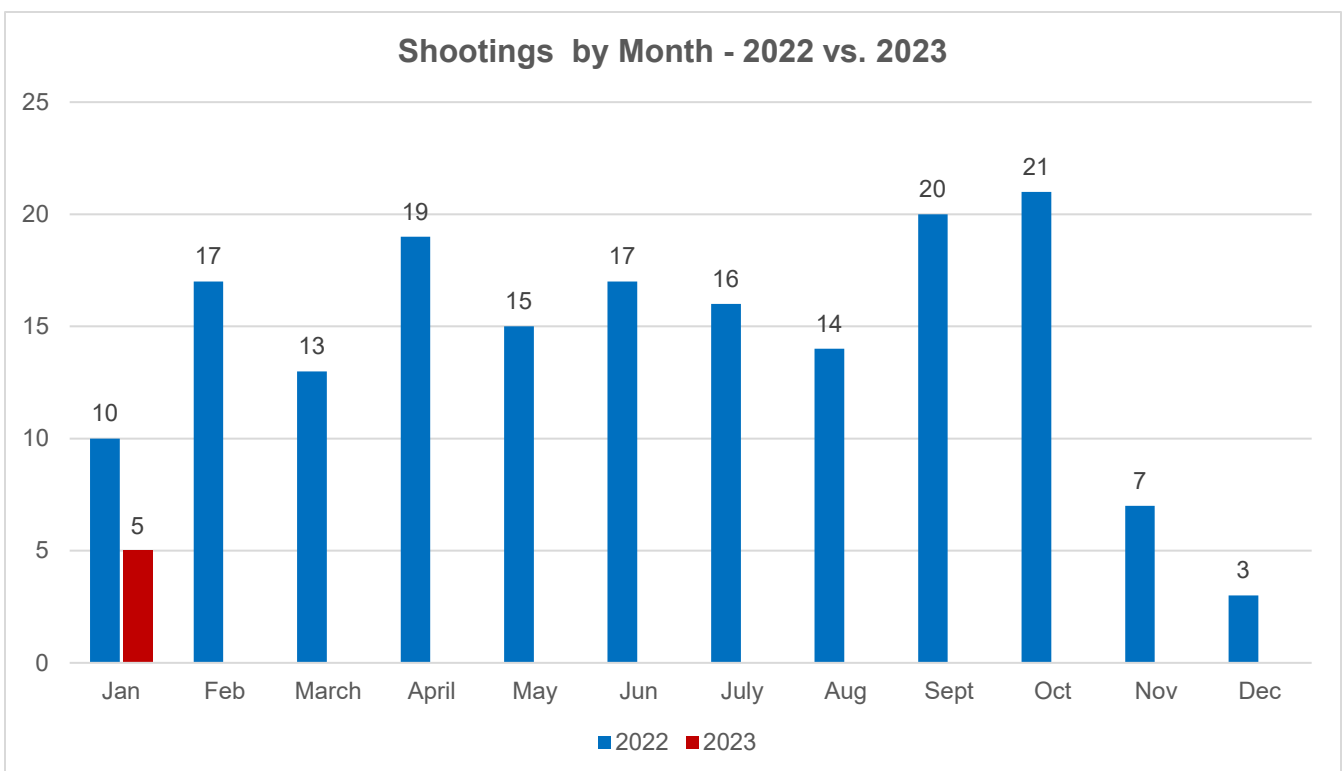

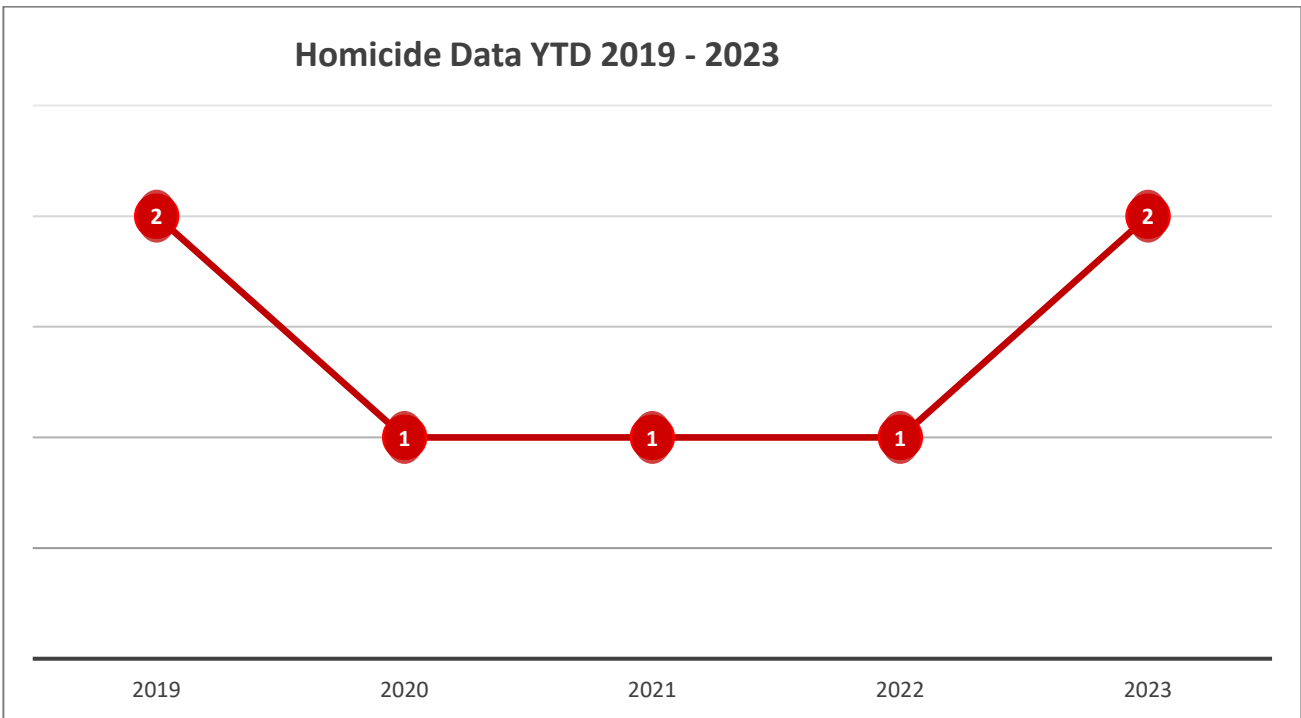
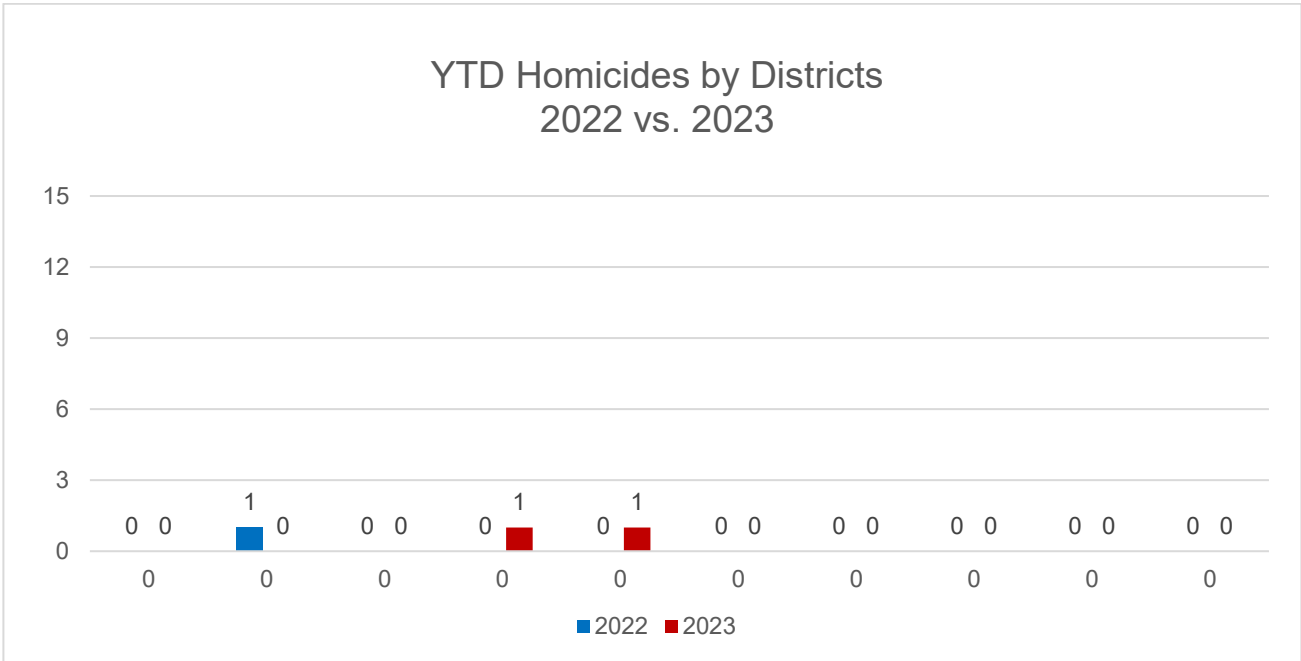
GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 7% compared to 2022

- There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 1 individual for the week ending 01/08/23
- An additional 3 victims suffered non-fatal injuries in the homicide incident on 01/06/23
 - There are a total of 5 incidents resulting in 8 victims
- There were 2 homicide incidents reported the week ending on 01/08/23
 - There are 2 homicides YTD with 2 incidents resulting from a firearm.
