- **7%** **The officer failed to comply with Department General Order 5.01.**
- **5%** **The officer prepared an incomplete or inaccurate incident report.**

Call for service involved assault, behavior health crisis, burglary, domestic violence, neighbor dispute, larceny, sexual assault, motor vehicle theft, and noise complaints.
