The Fire Department respectfully requests the attached Fire Health Checks PSC #49532-22/23 be added to an upcoming 2023 Civil Service Commission Meeting — whatever meeting date is at the earliest convenience of the Civil Service Commission.

PSC #49532-22/23 was pulled at the January 25, 2023, Civil Service Commission meeting, because the UAPD unions were not listed in the Personal Services Contract, Section 2. The UAPD President, Pierre King, was notified outside the PSC via email. Thank you very much for catching this: the PSC is now displaying all notified unions, including UAPD. Documentation is uploaded to PSC and included in this packet.

For reference, Fire Dept Occupational Health Physical Fitness Examinations PSC #43377 – 19/20 was last approved on January 8, 2020. We need a new Personal Services Contract due to the necessity of new dates and additional dollar amount. This Contract is essential because neither the SF Fire Department, nor San Francisco General Hospital, has the facilities and equipment necessary for this kind of specialized cardiovascular testing, and therefore cannot perform essential parts of the cardiac examination.

The Fire Department Physician reached out to SFGH Employee Health department to inquire about providing health check examinations, and Angela Boilard, Clinic Manager, at SFGH-Zuckerberg Hospital Employee Health verified via email to the department that they do not have the capacity to perform health check examinations and 5 stress treadmill tests/day.
