At the meeting of the Police Commission on Wednesday, November 2, 2022, the following resolution was adopted:

## **RESOLUTION NO. 22-148**

APPROVAL TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION URGING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,000,000.00 FROM THE CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 CALIFORNIA VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION PROGRAM TO REDUCE SHOOTINGS AND HOMICIDES, REDUCE RECIDIVISM AND VICTIMIZATION, AND BUILD TRUST IN THE LEGITIMACY OF THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE DEPARTMENT, SPECIFICALLY INDIVIDUALS IMPACTED BY GUN VIOLENCE

RESOLVED, that the Police Commission hereby urge the Board of Supervisors to retroactively authorize the Police Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$6,000,000.00 from the California Board Of State And Community Corrections for the fiscal year 2022 California Violence Intervention and Prevention Program to reduce shootings and homicides, reduce recidivism and victimization, and build trust in the legitimacy of the San Francisco police department, specifically individuals impacted by gun violence
